WV Total Deer Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. Preliminary counts of game checking tags indicate West Virginia hunters harvested a total of 131,444 white-tailed deer during the recently completed bucks-only, antlerless, muzzleloader, archery and youth/Class O/Class XS deer seasons, according to Division of Natural Resources Director Frank Jezioro. This year's total harvest was three percent below the 2011

deer harvest of 135,696. A total of 56,658 bucks, 45,169 antlerless season deer, 24,571 bow-killed deer and 5,046 muzzleloader season deer were taken during the 2012 season.

Antlerless Deer Season

The 2012 antlerless deer season, which includes the youth/Class Q/ Class XS deer season, was 12 percent above 2011 and one and onehalf percent below the five-year average of 45,845. "It is important to note that the antlerless harvest is the key component to any deer management strategy, as it controls the future deer population," said Jezioro. "Many counties had liberalized antlerless hunting seasons in 2012, including 10 counties that required hunters to harvest an antlerless deer before harvesting a second buck with a gun or bow, and a new October antlerless firearms season in all open counties. These modifications to the antlerless season structure led to an increase in the continue to the next page

the harvest and will ensure that deer populations do not exceed management objectives." The top 10 counties are: Preston (2,343), Mason (2,026), Jackson (1,759), Wood (1,608), Lewis (1,575), Upshur (1,569), Harrison (1,511), Ritchie (1,391), Monongalia (1,340) and Randolph (1,325).

Muzzleloader Deer Season

The 2012 muzzleloader harvest of 5,046 was 36 percent less than the 2011 harvest of 7,873 and was 37 percent below the five-year average of 7,969. "A change in season dates and an above-average acorn crop contributed to the decline in the muzzleloader harvest," Jezioro said. The top 10 counties are: Preston (237), Randolph (230), Nicholas (219), Braxton (216), Webster (203), Jackson (173), Fayette

B.A.S.S. Classic Blunders

The Bassmaster Classic is a tournament where heroes are made, winners become household names and careers are galvanized. Every B.A.S.S. fan can recount the Classic exploits of Bobby Murray, Rick Clunn, Bryan Kerchal and Kevin VanDam. Their stories are legend.

But there's another side to that same coin, and it belongs to the anglers — many of them every bit as talented as their championship-winning counterparts — who fell short and missed their chance at Classic immortality.

In chronological order, here are three Bassmaster Classic collapses.

1975

The 1975 Bassmaster Classic on North Carolina's Currituck Sound was supposed to belong to Paul Chamblee, a man who would qualify for all six Classics between 1974 and 1979 and who just might be the best angler in B.A.S.S. history that never won a tournament. Chamblee lived in Raleigh, and though he had

little experience on the tournament waters, he lived up to early predictions with a huge catch on the first day.

B.A.S.S.

Chamblee used a black single-spin spinnerbait to take a limit of 8-bass weighing an impressive 26 pounds, 1 ounce on Day 1. It was enough to grab the lead by almost four pounds over lure-making legend Tom Mann. Jack Hains, fishing his first Classic, was more than 10 pounds back, in 10th place.

Day 2 wasn't quite as good to Chamblee. He was one short of a limit with 12-6, but things were still looking up. Despite the slower fishing, his lead was growing. He was now 5-15 ahead of his closest competitor, but that angler was now Hains, who came on strong in the second round. The biggest thing going for Chamblee was that

area, making fishing extra tough. If he could post any kind of catch in the finals, he'd almost certainly win. As one competitor put it, "The good Lord is looking out for Paul Chamblee."

But it seems He must have been looking out just a little bit more for Hains, ironically now a preacher, because Chamblee struggled mightily on the final day. In fact, he failed to catch a keeper, while Hains caught six that weighed 12-12, giving him 45-4 for the tournament and the win.

To add financial injury to the Chamblee's insult, the 1975 Classic was winner-take-all — the last of five such championships — and Hains got every nickel of the \$15,000 prize money.

If you look at the list of Classic winners, you'll see that Hank Parker won the 1989 contest, but if you

check a little more closely you'll find that it's the championship Jim Bitter lost. In the annals of bass fishing, no other angler and fish exemplify "the agony of defeat" quite like Bitter and a small keeper bass from the final round.

B.A.S.S.

Jim Bitter has a good grip on this bass.

Not only did Bitter lead the first two days of the 1989 Classic, he also had the heaviest catch on both days. With a lead of nearly 4 pounds going into the final day of some tough fishing on the James River, he could sew things up with a limit.

And he had one fairly quickly. Swinging his fifth keeper into the boat, Bitter confidently walked toward the livewell, feeling good about his chances.

Then Tim Tucker, the late senior writer for Bassmaster Magazine

and Bitter's press observer for the day, asked if he was sure the fish was 12 inches long.

Well, Bitter was pretty sure, but not certain, so he stepped back toward the bow of the boat, measured the fish — it was comfortably over 12 inches — and turned to take it to the livewell.

Just at that moment, the fish twisted slightly in his hand, and Bitter continue to the next page

dropped it. It hit the gunnel of the boat and bounced back into the river.tt was the last bass he caught all day.

Back at the weigh-in, Bitter watched in horror as his catch fell two ounces short of Hank Parker's three-day total. Bitter had the win in hand -quite literally -but it slipped away. Almost 25 years later it is still the biggest blunder in tournament fishing history, and Bitter ranks as the Bill Buckner of fishing, a great competitor best known for one unfortunate moment. 1990

Aaron Martens gets a lot of publicity by virtue of his four runnerup finishes in the Bassmaster Classic, and it's true that the Natural has had his share of close calls. But Tommy Biffle may be even more deserving of the bridesmaid title in bass championships. Not only has he finished second in two Classics. but he's done it three other times in the FLW championship.

It all started in 1990 on the James

River. That was the third straight year bass fishing's greatest championship was held on the Virginia waterway, and each of the previous two events had been won in difficult to reach backwaters. Biffle figured the trend would hold and was catching his bass far up the Appomattox River. He took the first round lead by pitching jigs and worms to shallow cover.

In 2013, Tommy Biffle hopes to exorcise the demons that cost him the 1990 Classic.

By the time the second round ended, Biffle had padded his lead and was up by 6 pounds, 10 ounces. It was clearly his tournament to win.

Unfortunately for Biffle, his productive area was getting muddy due to boat traffic, and he had no backup plan. Rather than abandon the area that had produced his lead, he decided to stick with it and boated just one bass weighing 1-14.

It wasn't enough.

That Biffle would be passed after

struggling in the finals might not be so shocking except for how it happened and who went on to win the tournament.

Rick Clunn ended the first day in 14th place, nearly nine pounds behind the leader. Things didn't get any better on Day 2, either. He had a limit, but they weighed less than seven pounds and that put him in 10th place, 9-10 behind Biffle. If Clunn was going to have a chance, everything would have to go his

Not only did Biffle struggle in the finals —along with just about everyone between Clunn and the leader -but Clunn had the best day of the tournament. He was in "the zone," working his square bill crankbaits around cypress trunks and knees for a limit that weighed 18-7. Not only was it enough to surpass Biffle, but it eclipsed him by almost seven pounds!





New State Record Yellow Perch

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – The new state weight record for yellow perch now belongs to Joshua Wayne Estes of Hurricane, W.Va., according to Frank Jezioro, Director of the Division of Natural Resources. Estes caught the 14.5-inch, 1.93-pound fish at Summers-ville Lake in Nicholas County on December 1, 2012, using a live chub for bait.

His catch establishes a new West Virginia record for weight. The previous weight record for yellow perch was 1.83 pounds, caught by Charles Mayle from Tygart Lake in Taylor County in 1985. The length record for yellow perch of 15.44 inches still stands and was caught by Craig Hollandsworth from Summersville Lake in 2010.

Anglers who believe that they have caught a state record fish should check the record listing in the current West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Fishing Regulations brochure. The brochure also outlines the procedure to follow for reporting a state record catch. This information is also available online at www.wvdnr.gov.

West Virginia Fall **Turkey Harvest**

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va.

- Preliminary figures for the 2012 fall turkey hunting season show a harvest of 1,233 turkeys, according to Curtis I. Taylor, Chief of the Wildlife Resources Section of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. The 2012 harvest was four percent higher than the 1,186 birds checked in during the 2011 fall season and three percent higher than the five-year average. Three districts saw increases above average harvests, while the other three districts had slight decreases.

"Fall wild turkey harvests are highly influenced by hunter participation, annual recruitment of young turkeys and hard mast conditions," said Taylor. "The aboveaverage but scattered acorn crop of 2012 concentrated birds in areas of abundant mast, making those birds somewhat more susceptible to har-



vest, especially in our non-traditional, fall hunting counties."

Top counties for 2012 were Greenbrier (139), Nicholas (98), Randolph (91), Monroe (89) and Summers (71). The traditional fall hunting counties, including Preston County, the Eastern Panhandle and the mountain regions of the state, accounted for 56 percent of the total fall kill, which was almost identical to last year. Interestingly, these same traditional fall counties contributed only 19 percent of the total spring wild turkey hunting season harvest in 2012.



Rods For All Kinds Of Fishing

Fly Fishing

Fly Fishing rods are long, thin, flexible fishing rods designed to cast a fly (see Fly lure), usually consisting of a hook tied with fur, feathers, foam, or other lightweight material. Originally made of split bamboo, most modern fly rods are constructed from man-made composite materials, including fiberglass, carbon/graphite, or graphite/boron composites. Instead of a weighted lure, a fly rod uses the weight of the fly line for casting, and lightweight rods are capable of casting the very smallest and lightest fly. Typically, a monofilament segment called a "leader" is tied to the fly line on one end and the fly on the other.

Each rod is sized to the fish being sought, the wind and water conditions and also to a particular weight of line: larger and heavier line sizes will cast heavier, larger flies. Fly rods come in a wide variety of

line sizes, from size #0 rods for the smallest freshwater trout and panfish up to and including #16 rods[1] for large saltwater gamefish.

Fly rods tend to have a single, large-diameter line guide (called a stripping guide), with a number of smaller looped guides (aka snake guides) spaced along the rod to help control the movement of the relatively thick fly line. To prevent interference with casting movements, most fly rods usually have little or no butt section (handle) extending below the fishing reel. However, the spey rod, a fly rod with an elongated rear handle, is often used for fishing either large continue to the next page

rivers for salmon and steelhead or saltwater surf casting, using a twohanded casting technique. See Fly fishing.

Fly rods are manufactured by a number of companies and custom rod building is an active form of hobby among fly fishermen. You must treat yourself and visit a true master builder of fishing rods. They are magnificent works of art!

Spin Casting Rods

Spin casting rods are rods designed to hold a spin casting reel, which are normally mounted above the handle (See Fishing reel). Spin casting rods also have small eyes and a forefinger grip trigger. They are very similar to bait casting rods, to the point where either type of reel may be used on a particular rod.

Spinning Rods

Spinning rods are made from graphite or fiberglass with a cork or PVC foam handle, and tend to be between 5 and 8.5 feet (1.5 - 2.6 m) in length. Typically, spinning rods have anywhere from 5-8 large-diameter guides arranged along the underside of the rod to help concontinue to the next page

Unlike bait casting and spin casting reels, the spinning reel hangs beneath the rod rather than sitting on top, and is held in place

Spinning rods and reels are widely used in fishing for popular North American sport fish including bass, trout, pike and walleye. Longer spinning rods with elongated grip handles for two-handing casting are frequently employed for saltwater or steelhead and salmon fishing. Spinning rods are also widely used for trolling and still fishing with live bait.

Ultra-light Rods

These rods are used to fish for smaller species, they provide more sport with larger fish, or to enable fishing with lighter line and smaller lures. Though the term is commonly used to refer to spinning or spin-cast rods and tackle, fly rods in smaller line weights (size #0 - #3) have also long been utilized for ultra-light fishing, as well as to protect the thin-diameter, lightweight end section of leader, or tippet, used in this type of angling.

Ultra-light spinning and casting rods are generally shorter (4 - 5.5 feet is common) lighter, and more limber than normal rods. Tip actions vary from slow to fast, depending upon intended use. These rods usually carry 1 to 6 pound (4.5 to 27 N) test fishing line. Some ultra-light rods are capable of casting lures as light as 1/64th of an ounce - typically small spinners, wet flies, continue to the next page

crappie jigs, tubes, or bait such as trout worms. Originally produced to bring more excitement to the sport, ultra-light spin fishing is now widely used for crappie, trout, bass, bluegill and other types of pan fish.

Ice Fishing Rods

These are typically very short spinning rods, varying between 24 and 36 inches in length, used to fish through holes in the cover ice of frozen lakes, rivers and ponds. Surf Rods

Surf casting rods resemble oversized spinning or bait casting rods with long grip handles intended for two-handed casting techniques.

Generally between 10 to 14 feet (3 - 4 m) in length, surf casting rods need to be longer in order for the user cast the lure or bait beyond the breaking surf where fish tend to congregate, and sturdy enough to cast heavy weighted lures or bait needed to hold the bottom in rough water. Some surfcasters use powerful rods to cast up to six ounces of lead weight, artificial lures, and/or bait hundreds of feet.

History of fishing rods and rod design

Judging by stone inscriptions, fishing rods go back to ancient Egypt, China, Greece and Rome. Prior to widespread availability of synthetic materials, such as fiberglass and graphite composites, fishing rods were typically made from split Tonkin bamboo, Calcutta reed, or ash wood, as it was necessary that they be made light, tough, and pliable. The butts were frequently made of maple, with bored bottom; this butt outlasted continue to the next page

outlasted several tops. Handles and grips were generally of cork, wood, or wrapped cane. Guides were made of simple wire loops or, later, loops with ring-shaped agate inserts for better wear. Even today, Tonkin split-bamboo rods are still popular in fly fishing.

Rods for travelers were made with nickel-silver metal joints, or ferrules, that could be inserted into one another forming the rod. Some of them were made to be used as a walking cane until needed for sport. Since the 1980s, with the advent of flexible, yet stiff graphite ferrules, travel rod technology has greatly advanced, and multi-piece travel rods that can be transported in a suitcase or backpack constitute a large share of the market.

In theory, an ideal rod should gradually taper from butt to tip, be tight in all its joints, and have a smooth, progressive taper, without 'dead spots'. Modern design and fabrication techniques, along with advanced materials such as graphite and boron composites have allowed rod makers to tailor both the shape and action of fishing rods for greater casting distance, accuracy, and fish-fighting qualities. Today, fishing rods are identified by their weight (meaning the weight of line or lure required to flex a fullyloaded rod) and action (describing the location of the maximum flex along the length of the rod).

Modern fishing rods retain cork as a common material for grips.

Cork is light, durable, and tends to transmit rod vibrations better than synthetic materials, although EVA foam is also used. Reel seats are often of graphite-reinforced plastic, aluminum, or wood. Guides are available in steel and titanium with a wide variety of metal alloy inserts replacing the classic agate inserts of earlier rods.







Record Black Bear Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. - West Virginia hunters harvested 2,685 black bears during the combined 2012 archery and firearms seasons, according to Colin Carpenter, Black Bear Project leader for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. The preliminary harvest for the combined 2012 seasons was 34 percent higher than the 2011 harvest of 2,009 bears and 12 percent higher than the previous record harvest of 2,392 established in 2010. The black bear harvest of 2012 marks the fourth time in the past five years that the harvest has topped 2,000.

"As predicted in the 2012 DNR Mast Survey and Hunting Outlook publication, mast conditions had a tremendous influence on the distribution of this year's bear harvest," said Carpenter. "The statewide oak mast index for 2012 was much higher than in 2011 but the distribution was spotty. This fact, combined with two additional weeks of archery hunting, allowed archers to


locate bears effectively and led to an increased archery harvest.

Abundant oak mast keeps bears active into the winter and makes these bears vulnerable to harvest during concurrent buck-gun and bear seasons and the traditional December firearms season. Favorable mast conditions, combined with multiple counties open during September, led to a large increase in the firearms harvest."

Hunters took 746 bears during the 2012 archery season. The top five counties were Webster (71), Nicholas (67), Randolph (57), Fayette (55) and Preston (51).

Firearms hunters harvested 1,937 bears during 2012. Hunters took 681 bears in September, 266 during the concurrent buck/bear season and 990 during the traditional December season. The top five

counties were Pocahontas (183), Pendleton (179), Randolph (163), Webster (151) and Greenbrier (148).

Trout Basics

Trout can be fished with very modest equipment and modest outlay of investment. Budget-friendly essentials for trout fishing are: 1) fishing reel, 2) fishing rod, 3) fishing line, 4) floats or sinkers, and 5) bait or lures (with hooks).

Reel. A fishing reel is needed to basically let out and bring (reel) in fishing line. Two common types of reels are the 'spinning' and 'spincast' reels. The spinning reel has exposed spool and line and is generally affixed to the underside of the fishing rod. The spincast reel

has covered spool and is affixed to the top of the rod. By either bail (spinning reel) or button (spincast) the line is allowed to be cast out. When the bail is flipped (spinning) or button released (spincast) the line can be reeled in. Both types of reels are affordable.

Rod. The fishing rod serves two main purposes. First, it is used to 'fling' the line, hook, and bait out to where the fish (hopefully) are. Second, it is used to 'absorb' the play of the fish, while at the same continue to the next page

time keeping the line taught. Without the 'spring' of the rod, a sudden yank by the fish may break the line; and if the line gets slack, the fish may become unhooked. A 'light' rod should be used for smaller fish, and stouter rod for bigger ones. 'Keep the rod tip up' the best advice once a fish is on, so that the rod can 'do its thing'. It is important that the rod and reel are compatible (for spinning versus spincast reels). Often they can be purchased together.

Line. Fishing line should be selected based on the size of fish being fished. Great multitudes of trout have been caught on `4-lb Test' line, some more on `6-lb Test', and many, even some big ones, on `2-lb Test'. The nomenclature referring to the tensile test strength of the line. Lighter line can be `flung' farther; and more of it fits on a given reel. More important than the `Test' strength of the line is the proper use of knots, discarding line when

it gets frayed or damaged, and not trying to 'hoist' a fish into the air with your rod and reel. Many a large trout have been (carefully) landed on very light line.

Floats or Sinkers. Floats or weights

are needed to 'keep' the bait, or lure, where it is supposed to be out in the water. They also greatly improve casting distance by providing more to 'fling' in the casting process. If the bait or lure is to be kept some distance from the water surface (say, fishing in a lake or pond), then the bait/hook can be set that desired distance below the float (or 'bobber'). If fishing in a stream with current, or deep continue to the next page



in a lake or pond, sinkers (or `split shot') may be needed on the line to get the lure or bait `down'. In a fast moving stream it may take considerable weight to get the bait or lure where wanted. While bobbers and weights are perhaps the most `nontechnical' (and least expensive) items on the list of gear, they are very important.

In the case of fishing with bait, a bare hook is tied to the end of the line, and then worm 'skewered' onto the hook. The trout bites or swallows the bait, and gets hooked (theoretically). The best all-time bait for trout is the night-crawler (big earthworm). Other common baits include (processed) salmon eggs, marshmallows, and



artificial baits. Alternately, various lures (or `spinners') can be used. Lures can look like bait, or they can be used to attract fish attention (spinners). Lures and spinners generally come with hooks. Some lures and spinners are effective in aggravating trout into attacking the lure. The trout will smack the lure with the side of his head, or with open mouth, and (hopefully) get hooked. Hooks are not to be used, however, to `snag' fish. (Generally continue to the next page

the only legal method of hooking trout is for the trout to engage the bait or lure; simply resting a big hook on the bottom of a lake and waiting for a fish to swim by is a `no-no'.)

The list of not-so-essential gear is long, and especially if one is not budget-minded. Some might consider a net essential, and polarized sunglasses. Many invest in `fishing vests' which have various pockets and places for various gear. A knife might be considered essential by some, and/or a boat, not to mention a fishing vacation to go along with the gear. Some might not leave the house without a stringer, or creel, to carry all the fish home with. Certainly purchase a license where one is required. But, on the other hand, even some of the most essential items are not all that essential. Not a few trout have been caught on a worm (or grasshopper) skewered to a hook tied to a short piece of line tied to the end of a stick.
