


agency's R3 efforts to recruit, retain and reactivate hunters, anglers, and outdoor participants."

Elk Restoration Project

SOUTH CHARLESTON, WV – The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) has utilized proceeds from a February lottery wild boar hunt to purchase a UTV in support of the ongoing Elk Restoration Project.

In conjunction with Natural Resource Partners (NRP), a special hunt was held between February 5-7 on NRP private lands in southern West Virginia. To be entered into the lottery, resident WV hunters were required to submit an application through the WVDNR licensing system and pay a \$10 non-refundable fee. Monies from the application fee benefited a variety of WVDNR programs, including the Elk Restoration Project.

"The UTV will be used almost daily on the Elk Project as we con-

tinue to monitor the population through the calf drops this summer," said WVDNR Elk Project Leader Randy Kelley. "It will also be invaluable during the winter months when we deploy new GPS collars. The UTV has proven to be less destructive to area roads when they are wet."

In total, 1,763 hunters entered the boar hunt lottery with 200 being chosen to participate. Over the three-day hunt, 65 boars were harvested in Boone and Logan counties.

"We were excited and honored to offer this special lottery hunt to resident hunters because there are limited places in West Virginia where you can hunt wild boar," said WVDNR Director Stephen McDaniel.

Extended Turkey Season

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.VA. — West Virginia's spring gobbler season is underway and turkey hunters have even more opportunities to bag a bird this year.

"Our spring gobbler season includes eight extra days this year, so hunters have even more chances to have a successful season," said Mike Peters, wild turkey and migratory game bird project leader for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. "For folks like me, who get cabin fever, this is a great time to get out and enjoy beautiful spring weather and our state's hunting traditions."

The regular spring gobbler season is open through May 23. All hunters 15 and older must purchase a West Virginia hunting license and follow the state's turkey hunting regulations, bag limits and game check requirements. Hunters can check game and purchase their license online at wvhunt.com.

"The eastern wild turkey is a magnificent bird and being able to pursue one is a really special experience," Peters said.

Peters said wild turkeys were almost wiped out in West Virginia until the WVDNR started a trap and transfer program in the 1950s.



Have an uncased firearm, bow or crossbow in their possession in the woods after 1 p.m.

Hunt with dogs

Use electronic calls

Hunt with the use of bait

Take more than one bearded turkey per day

Rollins Lake Recent Closing

EVANS, WV – Rollins Lake in Jackson County will be temporarily closed to fishing and other activities in mid-May due to upgrades to the dam and other areas, the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) announced. The nearby fishing access site on Mill Creek will also be closed during construction.

The upgrades, which are expected to take six months to complete, include improvements to the access road, parking area, spillway, fisherman's trail and handicap fishing pier. The project also includes in-

stallation of a boat dock near the existing boat ramp. Signs about the closure will be posted in affected areas. The lake is part of the Rollins Lake Wildlife Management Area.

WVDNR does not anticipate 2022 trout fishing to be affected at the

lake. However, if unforeseen circumstances result in a winter shutdown and delayed completion of the project, the agency will issue an updated news release. For more information about the closure, contact the WVDNR District 6 office in Parkersburg at 304-420-4550.





State Record Freshwater Drum

SOUTH CHARLESTON, WV – A West Virginia angler caught a state record freshwater drum on April 24 in Mason County.

John Gibson of Poca, WV, caught a 27.88-pound, 35.59-inch freshwater drum on the Kanawha River, breaking the previous record for weight (27 pounds) held by Charles Mickel Lott since 1989. Bill Dawkins maintains the record for length with a 37-inch freshwater drum caught in the Little Kanawha River in 1954.

Spring Crappie Fishing

These spring crappie fishing techniques will help you catch more crappie during this crucial time of the year for crappie fishing. The ice is getting off of the lakes, and the crappies will be starting to move to shallow water soon.

The areas that the crappies will be migrating to will be not only shal-

low areas but the areas with a lot of sediment and algae which you will find in the northern bay areas. Crappies migrate to these areas because this type of water warms faster than any other area of the lake.

They will also be spawning soon, so they are going to these parts of

those crappies are is if you have a kayak take it out on the lake and navigate the shoreline areas. Take your kayak into the bays and find downed trees and weeded areas. Go along these areas and cast using a beetle spin lure. Beetle spins are a fast and easy bait to use when you are looking for the areas that the spring crappies will be.

The use of the kayak makes it easy to get into these challenging areas that you would have a harder time fishing from shore. Once you find where the crappies are at you can switch to a jig and slip bobber or a hook minnow and slip bobber, whatever your preferred method of crappie fishing might be.

Jigs, Floats, & Bobbers

Get yourself some 1/32 to \Box Oz jigs and use floats or bobbers with them to suspend your lure over the crappies so that they can see the bait dangling there. A lot of the time the crappies that aren't active will see your jig sitting there for a while and will decide that it would be an easy target to go after.

You will want to play around with the color of the jig heads. Make sure that the jigs mimic minnows continue to page 22



and bugs because that is what crappies are feeding on in the spring, summer, and autumn months as well.

Pre-spawn

During the pre-spawn early spring, you will find crappies in the shallow weedy areas of the lake where they get the most oxygen. Pre-spawn crappie will be looking for some big meals to give them the energy they will need for when spawning time comes which isn't far off in most cases.

Crappies will be in large schools this time of year. Early spring is one of the best times of year to catch an abundance of crappie once you locate these schools of fish. You won't be able to pull the crappies in fast enough.

If you have a fish finder, it's a good idea to put that to use. It will go along way in helping you find

these large schools of crappies and at what depth they are hanging around. Because if you find the schools of fish but don't know how deep they are, you might be presenting your bait wrong to them and not catch anything. You want your bait to be suspended above them so that they see it and then devour it.

Minnows with a slip bobber or a float are good choices of live bait to use during the pre-spawn. Small-sized jigs that are 1/32 to 1/64 Oz, and look like insects are a good choice this time of year for artificial lures.

Spawn Time

When the water temperature starts to warm up around 60 to 70 degrees, Fahrenheit crappies will start their spawn time. The spawning time for crappie can last from two weeks to six weeks depending on the size of the lake. If the water is clear crappies will make their nests in water that is 3 to 6 feet deep. Muddy water you will find crappies spawning in waters that are 2 feet deep.

The more protection from wind



and lots of vegetation is where you will find spawning crappies. The best types of lures to use during the spawn time is spinning baits and small micro jigs using 4-pound test. Using this combination of line and bait will ensure that the baits move down slowly in the water enticing the crappies to strike if you're looking for the bigger sized crappies you will want to use a \Box oz jig and 6 to 8-pound test line.

Cast your jig into reedy areas and slowly reel them back in making sure your rod tip is kept high. You will want to use light-colored jigs like yellow and pink during the crappie spawn for optimal effectiveness. Pairing these light-colored jigs with tubes or plastic curly tails of the same colors help capture crappies during the spawn as well.

Post Spawn

Crappie Fishing TechniquesAfter crappies have spawned, it becomes more difficult to find and catch these fish. They become elusive, and most anglers don't both fishing for them until the fall. But you can still catch some nice crappies during this time of the year.

Crappies will head back to the deeper water where they were before the spawn. They like it there

sunken trees and logs, rock piles, and creek channels with drop-offs and ledges.

Fishfinders especially the ones with side-scan can come in handy after the spawn when looking for crappie. You will want to focus your attention on catching the males of the species during the post-spawn. When you find where those elusive crappies are hiding, you have to almost hand feed them the bait. Get it right in front of their mouths. This is because after spawning the fish are tired from the spawn and they don't move very far.

During the post-spawn, you will want to try various rigs and depths to get these crappies to eat. Get a few rods rigged up with multiple jigs. Grab some live minnows and start experiment with different depths until you find the right combination. It's finding that combination of baits and depth that's the hardest part when fishing crappie post-spawn. But once you find the areas and the right combination you can fill your freezer up with crappie!

Spring Crappie Fishing Techniques Conclusion

Spring Crappie FishingDuring the spring is the best time of year to be fishing for crappies. And if you use some of the techniques in this article and fish the right areas of the lake you will find and more than likely catch an abundance of crappie. During the pre-spawn is probably the best time of spring to be catching these fish. They will be headed to their spawning areas as soon as the water temperatures warm which is about 50 to 55 degrees Fahrenheit and the ice starts leaving the lakes. Crappies will be found in big schools during the pre-spawn as well.

At spawning time you will find



crappies in water depths that range from 2 to 6 feet deep. This will depend on how clear or muddy the water is. The murkier the water is, the shallower the fish will be. Spinning baits and micro jigs work well during the spawn. The water temperature will be 60 to 70 degrees Fahrenheit at this time. Post Spawn Can Be Challenging

If your fishing post-spawn, you will have a harder time finding the crappies and getting them to eat. So trying various rigs and depths will be vital in catching crappies during the post-spawn time. But once you find the right combination, you can catch crappie all day long! Consider post-spawn crappie fishing a challenge! When you start to bring them in you will be one accomplished and happy angler.

I hope this article on spring crappie fishing techniques helps you

Adkins Wins Bass Regional Tournament

ANDERSON, S.C. — After 30 years of fishing the West Virginia B.A.S.S. Nation, Willie Adkins Jr. will finally get to fish for a national championship.

Adkins caught a limit of bass weighing 10 pounds, 8 ounces Friday on the final day of the TNT Fireworks B.A.S.S. Nation Southeast Regional at Lake Hartwell to secure the victory with a three-day total of 34-13, earning \$5,000 and a spot in the 2021 TNT Fireworks B.A.S.S. Nation Championship.

"I'll never ask for anything else. I don't care if I ever make the Classic, this right here tops everything for me," Adkins said. "I probably won't do it again and I'm going to eat it up."

It was a moment Adkins thought he may never experience — for a number of reasons.

On his way to a tournament three years ago, Adkins was involved in a car accident that broke his left arm. Not only did the car accident leave doctors worried his arm may need amputation, Adkins also dis-

covered he had Stage 4 kidney cancer and surgery was performed to remove one of his kidneys.

"The boy who hit me saved my life. The doctors told me I wouldn't have lived six months if I hadn't found out," Adkins said. "They said I would lose my arm. I went to get a second opinion and the doctor told me he would see what he could do and he fixed it. Now I'm back fishing again."

When he received the winner's trophy from Tournament Director Jon Stewart, Adkins hoisted it above his head with both arms, celcontinue to page 29

When Adkins arrived at Lake Hartwell, his plan was to fish shallow water, similar to the style he fishes back home in West Virginia. To his delight, he was able to find some spawning activity in those shallow areas.

"I live to fish for bedding fish," Adkins said. "Anybody who knows me, if I can find them I can catch them because I love to fish that way. I'm going to have a heart attack one of these days on the front of that boat trying to catch a fish off the bed. It is so exciting to see a big fish grab your bait."

Throughout the week, Adkins targeted the spawners with a craw-imitating bait as well as a lizard. On the second day, he used a spinnerbait to target windy points around the main lake when the wind picked up in the afternoon. Adkins also gave credit to one of his co-anglers, Sam Nowalk, for helping him figure out Lake Hartwell.

After placing third on Day 1 with 13-6 and first on Day 2 with 10-15, Adkins began the final day targeting bedding bass and filled out his limit about three hours into the

event throwing a floating worm around docks.

Around 10 a.m., Adkins noticed a group of spotted bass schooling in the middle of the lake and proceeded to make several important culls that improved his Day 3 bag.

"It was unbelievable," he said. "I looked out in the middle and these big spotted bass started coming up. I ran out there with a big spinnerbait and caught two 3-pound spotted bass."

With just a few minutes to go, Adkins said he lost a fish that he estimated to be about 3 pounds and thought he lost the tournament.

"But I didn't need it," he said.

Adkins has a long scar on the back of his arm from surgeries to put replacement bones in his arm. While the cancer has not yet been beaten, Adkins said he is going to contin-



Musky Mortality Study

SOUTH CHARLESTON, WV — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVD-NR) has partnered with various state fish and wildlife agencies (Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina and Wisconsin), muskellunge angling organizations, Costal Carolina University and West Virginia University on a musky mortality project.

The study will help determine whether Muskellunge catchand-release angling during the summer poses a significant source of mortality in southern populations. Studies are concurrently taking place in the James River (VA) and Stonewall Jackson Lake (WV), as well as in a hatchery pond setting.

"We have implanted radio transmitters into several fish in all locations," said Jeff Hansbarger, WVDNR fish biologist. "We track these fish throughout the summer months to evaluate the effects that warm water


The goal of the project is for local anglers to catch half of the tagged fish on rod and reel during the warm water fishing period. Fish that are caught and released will be closely monitored for several days to determine whether an individual has survived or died after being caught and released.




