

The top five most popular places to camp in the world are 1) Mount Cook National Park, New Zealand, 2) Devon, England, 3) Loch Lomond and the Trossachs, Scotland, 4) The Alps, France, and 5) Hossa National Park, Finland.

Between 120–140 people die at U.S. national parks annually. This is actually a small number when you consider that over 280 million people visit the parks each year; so, the odds of dying are roughly one in two million.

The most common causes of death while camping at national parks are 1) drowning, 2) car accident, 3) falling, 4) suicide, and 5) other. Sibley Tent Fact

Sibley is referred to often in the 1966 film The Good, the Bad, and the Ugly.

Confederate States Army Officer Henry Hopkins Sibley invented the first modern tent in 1855. He modeled his "bell tent" after Native American tents, using canvas instead of buffalo hides.

Getting killed by wildlife is one of rarest ways to die while camping at a national park. However, in 2010, one unfortunate person was killed by an angry mountain goat.

Men are more likely to die while camping than women. Men ac-



Summer Bluegill

Summer brings long days and ample opportunity to fish 7 days a week, and one of the most popular species in the upper Midwest is bluegill. They are not tough to find and catch in numbers, but the big ones seem to disappear. Where do they go, and how does one catch them?

Bluegills in Lakes

There are plenty of smaller bluegills in the shallows all season long, and the vast majority of pan fish anglers fish them there. The problem is quality and size is generally poor. The big fish have moved out, and here is how to find them. After the spawn in early June, the bull bluegills (fish over 8.5") head to the first available break line looking for food and cover. Weed edges are the place to look from 6' to 12' on clear lakes and 3 to 6' on the dark water lakes. The really stained tannic waters will not support weeds deeper than a few feet. Where the weeds stop is where the larger fish will be for about a month. A small fishing bobber and

1/32-ounce jig tipped with Berkley GULP Maggots will do the trick. The larger fish won't like to come up for the jig, so place the jig about 3.5' or more under the float. Use 4# to 6# Berkley Trilene fishing line or Fireline, a medium light rod, and a size 10 spinning reel.

Finding the bluegills is easy with a Humminbird Side Imaging sPros4-1Source's Keith Worrall with a big bluegill caught on Berkley Gulponar, just cruise the edges marking waypoints where you see groups of fish on the edges. Frecontinue to the next page





quently the crappies will hang out with the larger bluegills, which usually is not something one would complain about. Once you have several schools marked, go back and methodically fish each school by spot-locking on them with Minn Kota or deploying a Talon shallow water anchor and begin looking for the nice ones.

A fly rod and small popper can really be fun if fly fishing is your preferred presentation. I would wait for late evening to fish them with a fly or popper, as with the low light the bluegills will rise to a presentation more readily.

As Summer progresses to middle July onward, a rarely fished pattern emerges that can offer some of the best fishing of the season. Search out mid-lake humps that come up to within a few feet of the surface, and stay off the top, that will support lots of smaller fish. Fish the deep edges around the hump vertical jigging with a 1/16 th ounce jig and the above-mentioned GULP. When you contact a school of tanker bluegills, hit the spot-lock and hold on them moving along slowly the direction the school seems to be moving. They will move along slowly, if the action slows a bit, move along the direction of the last couple captures. Weed humps are not better than rocks, the fishing depends on what the bluegills are eating, and both can provide the

insects they prefer. Walleyes, small mouth, rock bass, and other fish will be mixed in with your catch. The bluegills will be there all the way until Autumn.

New Laws For Reptiles And Amphibian Possession

New regulations making it unlawful to take or possess most native reptiles and amphibians for any reason are now in effect in West Virginia.

"Reptiles and amphibians are a valuable wildlife resource and unfortunately we've had several large poaching cases involving these animals," said Kevin Oxenrider, amphibian and reptile program leader for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. "When it comes to the illegal wildlife trade, people don't think about turtles, snakes and salamanders. But these animals call West Virginia home, so we want to make sure we're doing everything we can to protect them so they can continue to serve their ecological function in the environment."

PROHIBITED NATIVE WEST VIRGINIA AMPHIBIAN AND REPTILE SPECIES

The new regulations prohibit the taking and possessing of 26 salamander species, 13 frog and toad species, six lizard species, 23 snake species and 12 turtle species.



EXCEPTIONS TO NEW REPTILE AND AMPHIBIAN REGULATION

While the new regulations make it unlawful to take or possess native reptiles and amphibians, there are exceptions for individuals who have written permission from the WVDNR Wildlife Resources Chief. Individuals may also legally take and possess bullfrogs, green frogs, snapping turtles and eastern spiny softshell turtles.

"We know that these turtles and frogs are commonly collected for consumption, so we wanted to make sure there was an exception that allowed folks to still take them and eat them," Oxenrider said.

Additionally, property owners, lessees or their representative may kill or relocate any snake within a continue to page 18

place of residence, dwelling, structure used for domestic or commercial purposes, and outbuildings, including sheds and structures, gardens and fields used for agricultural crops and livestock.

AUTHORIZATION TO POSSESS LAWFULLY OBTAINED REP-TILES OR AMPHIBIANS

The new regulations also allow for individuals who came into posses-

sion of a prohibited native reptile or amphibian before March 23, 2021 to obtain an authorization letter from the WVDNR to lawfully maintain possession of the animal for the rest of its life.

Authorization letters can be requested online or by mail.

Those who wish to request an authorization letter by mail need to complete and send the download-

Whether you're a wildlife enthusiast or an angler or hunter, knowing how to spot animals in the wild is a valuable skill and enjoyable activity. With more than 80 species of amphibians and reptiles, 70 species of mammals, 178 species of fish and nearly 300 species of birds, West Virginia is a great place to hone your wildlife identification skills. Here's a few tips to help you get started.

USE YOUR SENSES

To properly identify wildlife, you need to know what to look and listen for, so keep your eyes and ears open. Animals provide plenty of clues and signs to help you identify them. As you look and listen in your backyard, in the woods or at a state park or forest, pay attention to an animal's:

pay attention to water availability, food sources, shelter and shade and other topographic features. Many animals are only found within certain habitats and ranges, so paying attention to the location of an animal can help you identify its species.

CONSULT A FIELD GUIDE OR ASK AN EXPERT

Thanks to field guides and smartphone apps, identifying animals in the wild has never been easier. Many apps can help you identify an animal by photo, but we recommend starting out with a tried-andtrue field guide. Not only do field guides help you hone your wildlife identifying skills, they don't need cellphone service to work. You can purchase wildlife field guides for North America and West Virginia online. Many state park gift shops also carry state-specific field guides.

And when in doubt, ask an expert. Not only can WVDNR wildlife biologists and state park naturalists help you identify an animal, they can teach you all about that animal and its habitat.

WVDNR Deer Study

Big bucks, young bucks, does and fawns. Thanks to a new West Virginia Division of Natural Resources study, hunters, conservationists and wildlife enthusiasts will soon know more about the state's white-tailed deer population, their survival raises, behavior and movement patterns.

"We captured 98 deer this past winter and placed GPS collars around their necks so we can collect location data that will help us learn a lot about survival and hopefully give us a better picture of what causes deer mortalities," said Brett Shelly, assistant deer project leader for the WVDNR. "We are also looking at where bucks go during the rut and where does are fawning around the state."

The project is in the first of three years and includes three study areas: Hampshire, Barbour/Upshur and Jackson/Mason counties.

"This is only the second time we've put collars on deer since the early 2000s, so we hope to get a lot of information about deer survival, habitat selection and movement rates," Skelly said.

Some of the things Skelly hopes to learn include:

What causes deer deaths around the state?

What are bucks doing during hunting seasons?

What kind of impact does chronic wasting disease have on the deer in Hampshire County?

Do more female deer survive to adulthood?

"Everything we learn in this study is going to help us make more informed management recommendations, which will have benefits for our state's deer population and the

hunting public," Skelly said.
CAPTURING DEER FOR THE
STUDY

Capturing deer and placing collars on their necks required a delicate touch. Deer were trapped and given an anesthetic. Skelly and his team also covered each deer's head with a blindfold to protect the eyes of the animal. After taking vitals, measurements and DNA samples, each deer was given ear tags and a collar and were then put in a safe place and given a reversal so they could get up and go on their way.

The GPS collars, which expand to accommodate swelling in a buck's necks during the rut, will send location data to Skelly every 12 hours. If a deer stops moving, he'll know where to go to determine if and how a deer died. Each collar has a three-year battery life and a release mechanism that automatically drops off after three years.

"After the study, we can retrieve the collars, refurbish them and use them again," Skelly said.

The WVDNR plans to collar more deer during the next two winters, following the Mountaineer Heritage season. Skelly said he expects the study to show that female deer survive at a higher rate than males, that younger deer have a higher mortality rate and that the leading

PUBLIC ACCESS SITE RE-QUIREMENTS AND PROHIBI-TIONS

Now that you know how to find access sites all over West Virginia, take some time to learn about regulations for using them. The following are regulations and prohibitions that apply to access sites in West Virginia.

Public boating and fishing access facilities shall be used solely for the purpose of launching and retrieving watercraft or fishing from the shore. No other use of access sites is allowed. After launching, vehicles shall be parked in available parking spaces.

Any law enforcement officer act-

ing under proper authority may prohibit an individual from launching a watercraft from any public boating and fishing access sites.

The following are prohibited at fishing and boating access sites: Consumption of alcoholic beverages or possession of an open container of alcoholic beverages.

Swimming or bathing.

Camping.

Open fires.

Trash disposal except where trash receptacles are provided.

Discharge of firearms, fireworks and explosives.

Leaving unattended watercraft. Commercial use except as authorized by the Director.

Parking of any vehicle or the mooring of any watercraft in such a contunue to page 31

Spinning Reels For Success

By Patrick Walters My third Bassmaster Elite Series season has drawn to a close, and I'm still fishing with most of the same spinning reels that started off in my boat during my rookie season. It may seem miraculous or unlikely — after all, much of the public assumes that we get as much tackle as we want, and just dispose of the previous gear — but it really shouldn't be surprising at all. Anglers who've bought quality spinning gear and taken care of it know that it can last a long, long time.

Those of us who are lucky enough to fish for smallmouth up north know that quality spinning tackle is a necessity, not a luxury, on those big water beasts. Sure, if you just fish ponds for smaller fish you might be able to get by with a lower-range product, but when you're testing your drags, fluorocarbon and braid-to-fluoro knots against hard-charging smallmouth, you better have the good stuff.

I can't tell you how many times I've heard other competitors complaining about six-month-old reels that suddenly locked up, usually mid-fight with a fish that would

That said, the majority of the spinning reels I carry with me are Daiwa Tatula LTs, which retail for \$199.99 apiece. That's well within the budget of most anglers, and it's actually a bargain when you consider their longevity. If you buy a \$50 reel or even a \$100 reel and it doesn't last you a full season, or gives out at the worst possible time, what kind of value is that?

Just because you don't live up north, or don't fish for smallmouth, don't assume that you shouldn't

have quality spinning gear in your arsenal. At home on Santee Cooper I've caught more largemouth over 7 pounds on spinning tackle than on anything else. I also use my spinning reels for saltwater applications along the South Carolina coast.

tackle after every saltwater outing, but to be totally honest beyond that I haven't done much maintenance to my Daiwa spinning reels. I might clean them up a little bit at the end of the season, knock the dirt off of them, but that's about it.

The "problem" is that my season never really seems to end, so there's never been a good gap of time to accomplish a more thorough cleaning regimen. I vow that later this year I'll break them down, clean them up and lubricate them as needed.

If you're not using spinning tackle a lot, then you are leaving quality catchable fish behind, and if you're not using the right quality spinning tackle then you'll never maximize your success. When we go up north, it's not necessarily a matter of who is going to get big bites we all get them — but rather who is going to land the majority of those big bites.

I have not yet gotten to the point where I put them all in the boat, but when I hook into a big, mean smallmouth on 8- or 10-pound

braid with a 6- or 8-pound test fluorocarbon leader, I know that the margin for error is small. The fight may take a minute, or it may take seven minutes. I've heard that Taku sometimes fights them for eight to 10 or even more minutes.

In order to remain patient and confident during that battle you have to know that your gear is bordering on infallible. You have to know that it's not going to lock up on you or even "catch" enough to cause the line to part. That's the kind of confidence I have in my spinning reels, even after three-plus years of heavy use and occasional abuse.
