WV Deer Hunting Information

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. — The 2018 West Virginia buck firearms season began Monday, Nov. 19 and run through Dec. 1. Here are a few facts about the season:

Buck firearm season is open in all counties except Logan, Mingo, McDowell and Wyoming.

Sunday hunting will be legal on public lands throughout West Virginia, and on private land with written permission of the land-owner. The only Sunday that falls within the two-week buck firearms season is Nov. 25.

All deer harvested by hunters in Berkeley and Mineral counties on Nov. 19 and 20 are required to be brought to a designated Biological Game Examination Station. For station locations, consult page

12 of the 2018-2019 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Summary.

Approximately 250,000 deer hunters will be in West Virginia's woods this season.

Hunters should review the 2018-2019 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Summary for detailed instructions concerning bag limits and season dates. The regulations are available at license agents, DNR district offices and online at www.wvdnr.gov.

All hunters must use their permanent DNR ID number to check game. The ID number can be found on annual hunting licenses. Hunters who have registered with the electronic licensing system in the past must use the number they were previously provided. They also can be obtained by calling 304-558-2758 or logging on to wvhunt.com and providing the requested information. Game may be checked by telephone at 1-844-WVCHECK, online at wvhunt.com or at any hunting license agent. All field tagging, transporting and possession requirements still apply.

Hunters may substitute a bow or a crossbow during the buck firearms season.

(one on the base license and one on an RG [resident] or RRG [nonresident] stamp). A hunter may take no more than three antlered deer per calendar year in all archery, crossbow and firearms seasons combined.

A hunter may harvest two deer per day, but only one antlered deer may be harvested per day. The first deer does not have to be electronically registered before harvesting the second deer in the same day. However, all deer legally harvested must be electronically registered and legally tagged before hunting during a subsequent day.

The last day to purchase an additional buck deer gun tag (Class RG/RRG Stamp) is Sunday, Nov. 18. Class RG and Class RRG additional buck stamps can only be used to take an additional antlered deer during buck firearms season.

Unused Class RG and Class RRG stamps may not be used in antlerless or muzzleloader seasons.

Fifty-one counties are open to concurrent antlerless deer season hunting during the traditional buck firearms season. Class N (resident) or Class NN (non-resident) stamps to hunt during the antlerless deer season can be purchased at any time. Antlerless deer firearms season opens Nov. 19 on private land and specified public lands. Hunters should consult the 2018-2019 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Summary for specific antlerless deer season regulations in each county and wildlife management area.

A bear firearms season without dogs will run concurrent with the buck firearms season in 51 of 55 counties, excluding Logan, Mingo, McDowell and Wyoming. Con-



Virginia, much of it in the rural areas of the state that depend upon the deer seasons for a large portion of their annual income. Hunting is estimated to be responsible for 5,400 jobs and \$35 million in sales taxes on goods and services spent in West Virginia.

In 2017, the traditional bucks-only firearm season harvest of antlered bucks was 44,127, a decrease of 4 percent from the 2016 harvest. This is 14 percent less than the 5-year average bucks-only firearm season harvest of 51,448 and ranks 35th among all past years.

WVDNR predicts the buck harvest will be higher than it was in 2017. White oak mast will have the deer spread across the landscape, but the lack of other oak species will make it easier for hunters this year than last season. Field reports are showing a very healthy deer population and many good bucks available.

Hunters are required to wear at least 400 square inches of blaze orange (about the size of a vest) as an outer garment for visibility and safety. Blaze orange camouflage patterns are legal as long as 400 square inches of blaze orange are displayed on the garment. A blaze orange hat is not required, but the hunter must have blaze orange visible from both the front and the

back.

Hunting licenses may be purchased online at any time and printed out on a home computer printer. Go online to www.wvhunt.com, fill out the application and purchase it over a secure server with a credit card.

Hunters who wish to donate deer meat or money to the Hunters Helping the Hungry program, which distributes deer meat through the Mountaineer Food Bank and the Facing Hunger Food Bank, should call 304-924-6211 or visit the DNR website at www.wvdnr.gov to find a participating meat processor.

Bobcat Trappers Needed For Study

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is asking bobcat trappers to assist with a new study in Berkeley, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Jefferson, Mineral, Morgan, Pendleton, Pocahontas, Randolph and Tucker counties.

"We're asking trappers in those counties who catch bobcats to call wildlife biologists so a research crew can place a radio collar on their animal and release it," said Gary Foster, assistant chief for Wildlife Management. "A \$100 gift card, useable at several locations, will be awarded to all trap-

pers contributing an animal for the study."

Animals caught and released will not count toward the trapper's seasonal bag limit, and trappers may contribute multiple animals to the study. The study will help DNR refine the population model used to manage bobcats in the state and guide harvest recommendations in the future. Radio-collared bobcats will yield important data regarding home range size, habitat use and mortality factors. The study will take two trapping seasons to complete and biologists are hoping to collar 30 bobcats each season.

Upon trapping a bobcat in the targeted counties, trappers should leave the animal on site and call one of the numbers listed below during normal business hours, Monday through Friday. A research crew will be dispatched to process and release the animal. Trappers should not keep animals through the weekend or holidays, as research crews will not be available to respond.



Fall Turkey Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – West Virginia turkey hunters harvested 1,215 birds during the fall season, according to the Division of Natural Resources. That's an increase of 28 percent above the 2017 season, and only 4 percent below the five-year average.

"Even with the incredibly wet summer we had this year, poult production was up from last year," said Mike Peters, DNR game bird biologist. "That was a good indication fall harvest would also be up, as was predicted in the 2018 West Virginia Mast Survey and Hunter Outlook."

Two main factors contributed to the improved harvest numbers, according to Peters. Brood production was up from last year and mast conditions were slightly below the long-term average. Poor mast conditions will concentrate birds and make it easier for hunters to bag a bird. The uptick in harvest from last year could also be attributed to the increase in hunting opportunity. "It's the third year all 55 counties

had at least a one-week season, but it's the first year that Sunday hunting was permitted in all 55 counties on both private and public land," Peters said.

Leading the state was Randolph County, with hunters harvesting 76 birds, followed by Nicholas (68), Greenbrier (65), Upshur (58), and Preston County (54). The top three counties had a four-week season with Upshur and Preston County having a two-week season. District 3 hunters harvested 319 birds, followed by District 1 (232), District 4 (230), District 2 (168), District 6



Albino And Leucistic (Piebald) Deer

It turns out people have been captivated by white deer for centuries, and perhaps millennia. The ghost-like appearance of these animals has attracted myth, superstition and rampant scientific misinformation for an equally long period of time.

That misinformation continues to this day. And it stands to reason that, with whitetails becoming more abundant near population centers, more people will be sharing their own tales of these unusualcreatures.

White deer are real, but they may not be what you think.

Albino, Leucistic or Piebald?

Most people, like my grandfather, refer to white deer as "albinos." While deer can be albinos, it's exceedingly rare.

Albinism is a congenital condition defined by the absence of pigment, resulting in an all-white appearance and pink eyes. Many continue to the next page

It's difficult to accurately determine how frequently this condition exists in wild animals, because albino animals tend not to survive long. They have poor eyesight and are conspicuous, making them easy prey. Research suggests that albi-

The same undoubtedly holds true for deer, and in fact true albino deer are rarely reported. Instead, most white deer exhibit a condition commonly known as leucism, a recessive genetic trait found in about one percent of all white-tails. As with albinism, leucism can be found in nearly all mammals.

els of white - some contain white splotches, some are half brown and half white, some appear nearly all white. Mixed brown and white animals are often known as piebald deer. (Confusingly, many deer biologists and hunters use "piebald" to describe all leucistic deer).

The nose is black, as in a "normal" deer, and eyesight is not usually affected.

cism. Birders often report seeing unusual white birds (rendering field guides nearly incomprehensible). White squirrels have become famous tourist attractions in several U.S. towns.

Leucistic deer generally can survive longer than albino deer. Still, they are not very well camouflaged in the forest, making them stand out to predators. In a habitat with its large predators still present, a leucistic deer's chances of survival are slim.

As wildlife photographer and deer expert Leonard Lee Rue III notes in his recent book Whitetail Savvy (a must-read for deer nerds), "Many piebald deer also exhibit hunched backs, bowed legs, and short, rounded noses."

Today, human hunters are the most common large predator over much of the white-tailed deer's range. Humans bring their own selection pressures to hunting, and they're quite different from those of wolves or mountain lions.

I'd guess that, because of that, you're more likely to see a white deer today than at any point in the whitetail's history.



The 2018 harvest was 1 percent higher than the 2017 harvest. The top 10 counties for buck harvest in 2018 were: Randolph (1,685), Preston (1,607), Greenbrier (1,479), Hampshire (1,471), Jackson (1,379), Pendleton (1,274), Grant (1,217), Hardy (1,212), Kanawha (1,212) and Mason (1,206).

The buck harvest increased in the eastern panhandle (DNR District 2) and in southwestern West Virginia (DNR District 5) and was similar to or slightly down in the remainder of the state.

Deer hunters have several days of opportunity left this year, including the remainder of the archery and crossbow seasons, which run through Dec. 31. Muzzleloader deer season will open Dec. 10 and remain open through Dec. 16. The Youth, Class Q/QQ and Class XS

For all of these reasons and more. rabbit hunting used to be the main pursuit for hunters during the winter. And hunters didn't stop targeting rabbits in the winter because they didn't like the taste of the meat on their dinner tables, but because finding rabbits became difficult.

Nowadays, some hunters believe that going after rabbits in the winter is more trouble than it's worth. Certainly, the population of the cottontail and showshoe hoppers has thinned over time, thanks to factors ranging from habitat destruction to a preponderance of predators (covotes among them). However, rabbits are resilient animals with quick reproductive cycles, mean-



Must Tag Furbearers

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources would like to remind beaver, bobcat, fisher and otter trappers that they are required to electronically register their catches within 30 days after the close of the respective season. The furbearer trapping seasons in West Virginia opened Nov. 3.

A game check confirmation number issued by the DNR must be recorded in writing with the trapper's name and address, or written on a field tag, and must be attached and remain attached to each pelt or whole animal until it is sold, tanned or processed into commercial fur, or is mounted.

Information provided by hunters or trappers when checking game is

used to monitor the harvest and assist in future management of these species in West Virginia. Decisions regarding season length, opening and closing dates, and bag limits rely on accurate data obtained from electronic registration of the harvest.

you are unable to deliver the carcass. Biological samples collected will assist biologists in making decisions regarding future trapping seasons. A \$20 gift certificate will be issued for each useable otter carcass turned in.

DNR personnel advise trappers to obtain a Convention on International Trade of Endangered Species (CITES) seal for each bobcat and otter pelt from animals harvested in West Virginia. The plastic seal is necessary only if the pelts will be shipped out of the state. Federal law requires the seal on all bobcat

and otter pelts if they will eventually be shipped to international markets including Canada. The seals must be obtained from the state where the animals were harvested.

Bobcats and river otters are not endangered species but may be confused with similar-looking species that may be found on the international market. These CITES seals may be obtained from the DNR Elkins office and any DNR district office. Calling ahead is advised to ensure that personnel authorized to seal pelts will be available.

Winter Squirrel Hunting

When the leaves are off the trees and the weather is cold, squirrel season becomes the art of the sniper.

Here are our tips to aid in your success while late season squirrel hunting.

In early season when the leaves are on the trees, squirrels are less wary of intrusion into their domain and less likely to be spooked by the quiet hunter. In late season, after facing other hunters, they have become educated. Also, the leaves

that once hid the hunter are now gone.

This becomes the hunting game of the rifleman.

Hunters are wise to utilize full camouflage, including the use of face masks and gloves to mask their human presence. Moving ever so slowly, the hunter scans the tree tops with binoculars looking for that small part of the squirrel that might give them away. This may be a silhouette, a flickering tail, a tail blowing gently in the breeze, or its ever-present intensely black eyes.

Once located, the stalk begins to find a suitable spot to take a shot.

This is the hunt of the rifleman, as ranges are frequently more difficult than that of a shotgun's capability. The Ruger model 10/22 is a reliable .22 long rifle chambered weapon that is very effective on quick, accurate shots at squirrels at quite a distance.

The .22 long rifle cartridge is accurate and damages the meat little, especially if you take head shots.

Take a seat and become a stump. Find a large nut-bearing tree or a hollow tree and sit close enough to it to do your surveillance. Once the woods get quiet, the squirrels will start to travel again and you are bound to get a shot. Keep quiet, don't move and be patient. Tiny black eyes are watching you from above!

Good luck and be sure all of your shots you take have a solid backing, such as a tree, to stop the bullet after it exits your squirrel.

Hunting Winter Deer

The next time you find yourself scheduling vacation for deer hunting, consider flipping past Halloween and Thanksgiving and poring over the possibilities around December 10.Why? Well, it's not because of the so-called "second rut." Yes, rut activity sometimes occurs in early December, but it's minor.

The bigger factors are:

Hunger

Food availability

Cold weather

Little or no hunting pressure.

When those factors combine before mid-December — and you throw in random late-breeding activity for added spice — you'll often see deer activity that out-

shines the main rut of late October through mid-November.

True, breeding activity can tick upward in early December as doe fawns enter heat for the first time and an occasional doe recycles after failing to get pregnant four weeks earlier. But the second rut is more a last gasp than a second wind, and breeding in December north of the Mason-Dixon line results more from convenience and coincidence than relentless pursuit.

Although there's no guarantee the early to mid-December time frame will produce great deer activity each year, the ingredients for a deer hunter's "perfect storm" almost always swirl about that time. Those ingredients include:

ble foods, and hunger drives deer to make daylight appearances.

Food sources compress and food varieties dwindle.

In Northern regions, most crops have been harvested by then, and many acorns and nutritious leaves have been eaten or buried under early snowfalls. Deer congregate on remaining foods and deplete them further.

The whitetail's metabolism hasn't yet slowed for winter, which means hunger can be relentless.

They must find food to maintain their energy reserves, and when they find it, they'll stay longer to eat.







miserable cold snowy days, frozen northern winds, ice on the shorelines or similar stuff.

These aspects often represent what keep the bass fishermen away from the water

during the coldest months of winter. Well, not all of them. Those like me enjoy fishing for

the little green fish 12 months a year, experience, during the dead of winter, some of the

best bass fishing action, and catch QUALITY bass too!

strain, can be caught even through the ice if we are willing to fish for it. I've caught bass, and lot of them in waters partially iced up! The key to be successful in winter is SLOWING DOWN, sometimes leaving our lure motionless on the bottom for seconds if not minutes. It's tough fishing, which requires coninue to the next page

lot of self-conditioning, an excellent mental preparation and full concentration on the job at hand. As for these latter aspects, I compare winter fishing to tournament fishing.

Winter fishing is, for several aspects, a mental game. First of all, we have to convince ourselves that the fish is there and

coldest months of the year. Surely it will eat a less amount of food but it has to nourish itself to not die by starvation. So, mr. Bass will probably bite one of our lure... With that in mind, we'll have to consider that during spring, summer and fall we took particular care of two aspects to consistently catch fish: location and presentation. In winter it's exactly the same thing, maybe with some slight exceptions.

Another thing that plays to our favor in our mental game, is that winter bites, as I've already mentioned, are quality bites. There are also very good chances to catch those huge fish we have seen spawning last spring and which seemed disappeared for the rest of the year! Wonder why? For two reasons. First, because they're subject to almost no fishing pressure; second,

when the opportunity of an easy big meal arise, the big female bass is the first one to take advantage of this in winter.

LOCATION


Despite the most of anglers I've spoken with about winter fishing are convinced that sunny days are usually better, I'm not of the same opinion. I'm aware on how a prolonged period of sun affect bass behavior but in the dead of winter, sunny days oftencorrespond to lower air temperatures while cloud cover means warmer weather thatturns the fish a little more active and move them shallower. These are good ingredients for a productive winter trip. Over my years of extensive winter fishing, I've discovered that one of the best time to be on the water is when it's snowing. Snow seems to put some frenzy on the bass.

Since the days are shorter during winter, I've experienced some extra-time fishing in the dark, just because the bass were biting more aggressively than during the middle of the day! Just a thought, but sometimes winter fishing has big similarities with the hot summer fishing.

PRESENTATION

Fish normally moves slow and so it will accordingly feed on slow-moving baits. Presentation is one of the most mental aspect of winter bassin'. You need to retrieve your lures so slow that sometimes this results painfully, in the true sense of the word. It's even more hard in the beginning, after a wonderful fall season spent casting and retrieving spinnerbaits, topwaters and crankbaits.

When you think you're fishing slow, slow down again and again

lure, watching it and wondering if it is the case to bite it or not. Often, this is true: there's a fish watching and following your lure. Your task is to keep its interest high and convince it to bite.

Sometimes it will attack with vengeance and you'll see the line jumping and starting to run sideways like a rocket, but the most of the times you'll feel absolutely nothing.

With the experience, I developed a "sixth" sense, and well, I often set the hook on what this sixth sense tell me. When something is not right and you aren't able to feel your lure or this one is where it hasn't to be, reel in the slack line quickly and set the hook!

Concentration plays a big role in winter presentation: you've to try to become one with your lure and be always aware on where it is and what it's doing.

Coming back to the bass watching

and following our lure, I've found that shaking this one, brings a lot of interest from the fish. A good portion of the bites I get in winter comes while I'm shaking the lure. I feel or see the distinctive "thump" of the bass that all of sudden interrupts my shake. I usually add a shot of Kick'N Bass fish attractant to my lures. I believe this give me an advantage over the bass because this


