A new program and changes to a previous angling program will also take effect this year. The Master Angler Program is an exciting new opportunity for anglers to complete "slams" for specific fish species and also earn a lifetime award as a West Virginia Master Angler by completing all six slams. The rules and application can be found at WVdnr.gov/ fishing/fishing-regulations under "Fishing Forms."

The long-standing Trophy Citation Program is undergoing some changes beginning in 2022. The printed citations were completely re-designed and will feature new fish artwork from renowned artist, Joseph Tomelleri.

Additionally, instead of receiving a citation for each trophy fish reported, anglers will now get one citation for each species at the end of the calendar year, reporting the total number of trophies caught for that species. For example, if mouth bass. Each citation will you submit 15 citation applications for rainbow trout and five trophy caught for that species.



## **12 Top Rated Fishing Destinatons** In WV

West Virginia is an angler's paradise, not just because of the vast number of lakes, streams, and rivers flowing through the state, but for the variety of trout fishing opportunities available. The brook trout is the only native trout species in the state, but due to a robust stocking program through the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR), anglers can also catch rainbow, brown, and the unusual golden rainbow trout that originated in the Mountain State.

There are sections of waterways specifically designated for catch and release that appeal to recreational and fly rod anglers. Some sections of waterways are fly-fishing only, and some are designated as "general," which means anglers can fish year-round and harvest their catch.

More than 200 waterways are stocked throughout West Virginia, many of them in the mountainous eastern part of the state. The

WVDNR stocking program is multi-faceted: to stock some waters with trout that are sizable to harvest, to supplement the natural stock with fingerlings to help with trout reproduction, and to stock areas that have depleted populations by reintroducing trout.

While West Virginia has a robust stocking program in place, especially for rainbow, golden rainbow, and brook trout, a number of continue to the next page

streams, including the Cranberry, Williams, and Greenbrier River, are not stocked with brown trout since they are predatory toward other fish species. Brown trout are predatory toward the endangered candy darter for which these streams provide critical habitat.

The stocking schedule is different for every waterway and every year, so anglers should consult current schedules in each area.

"The stocking program provides a lot of fishing opportunities. We distribute it around the state, so folks have a location not too far from where they live to have access to trout fishing. Our goal is to not only provide fishing opportunities but a variety of fishing opportunities," says Jim Hedrick, Hatchery Program Manager for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.

The most unique trout in West Virginia waters is the golden rainbow trout. It is unique to West Virginia and originated in the state when one trout with golden bands was discovered in the 1950s. Over a period of reproductive years, a stock of 300 completely gold trout emerged and have been reproducing ever since.

You can find golden rainbow trout throughout the year, but anglers can also get in on "The Goldrush Program," which takes place each spring. It is designed to encourage kids to fish and celebrate the state's unusual, completely gold-colored, trout. One week each spring, certain streams are heavily stocked with golden rainbow trout. 

You can identify stocked sections, access points, and regulations about bait and catch-and-release or fly-only sections. Do not forget to get a state fishing license and review current fishing information at wvdnr.gov.

Narrow down your fishing options in West Virginia, with our list of the top rivers and lakes for trout in West Virginia.

#### 1. Cranberry River

The centrally located Cranberry River is surrounded by forest trout that can be harvested. Since

The catch-and-release, fly-fishing-only section is located upstream of the stocked waters in areas like Dogway Fork. This area in only accessible by foot or on bike. The stocked section of Cranberry River is a nearly 15mile stretch that runs parallel to Cranberry River Road, so there are many access points in the area.



2. Williams River

Another top trout waterway in West Virginia, the Williams River, is also in a wilderness area. The larger river system and backwoods experience appeals to trout anglers who are looking as much for the primitive outdoor challenge as they are the stellar day of fishing on the water.

The nearly 20-mile stretch of stocked waterway runs parallel to Williams River Road between North Cove Run and Swago Road. Rainbow, golden rainbow, and brook trout are stocked regu-

The Smoke Hole section of the South Branch River features natural forest land but it is not as remote as the trout sections of the Cranberry and Williams River continue to the next page

River systems. It is a bit more accessible for anglers looking for a rugged experience but it is not remote wilderness.

A 9.3-mile section of the South Branch River running parallel to Smoke Hole Road is stocked with rainbow, golden rainbow, brook and brown trout marked as general regulations except for one-mile section in the middle near Pretty Ridge Road that is catch-and-release only. The Smoke Hole section of river is located near the Virginia state line, and you are surrounded by the stunning view of the mountains.

#### 4. Shavers Fork River

River are preferred for trout fishing because there are multiple stream sections that feed into the main river that are also stocked with rainbow, golden rainbow, brook and brown trout. Most of the stocked river sections flow through Randolph County near Elkins. The main section starts on Spruce Knob, which is the highest point of the state, with nearly 50 miles of stocked water.



trout just below them, as well as fishing piers and nearby amenities.

The one advantage that these tailwater areas have, especially for novice trout anglers, is easy access to big water. While all are located in different areas, they are all in close proximity to interstates. This makes it easy to plan a day of trout fishing that does not involve a long trek to the water or a big time commitment. Jackson Lake has a resort nearby if you want to plan a longer trip.

#### 10. Greenbrier River

One of the new and exciting trout fishing areas in West Virginia is on the Greenbrier River. A section of the river will be stocked with rainbow, golden rainbow and brook trout beginning in 2019. The section starts at the Cass Scenic Railroad at the park with stocked areas following the rail

trail for several miles.

This is an exciting area to fish because there are several access points with parking areas that are right next to the stream. There are also a few sections that require walk-in or bike-in accessibility

for anglers looking for that additional outdoor challenge. The stocked areas are general designation, so fish are available for harvest.

The Cacapon State Park lakes sit in the shadow of Cacapon Mountain in the eastern panhandle of West Virginia. Two lakes within the park are stocked each spring with rainbow, golden rainbow, brook, and brown trout. These are recreational fishing lakes, so you will also see anglers fishing for bass, catfish, and bluegill.

The lakes at Cacapon State Park are not as secluded as other trout fishing areas in West Virginia, but they are easily accessible for anglers who do not want to venture into remote wilderness areas. The park is located near the town of Berkeley Springs, where you can base yourself if you do not plan to book a cabin or lodge within the state park.

#### 12. Spruce Knob Lake

The scenery at Spruce Knob Lake is as impressive as its trout fishing. It is a 23-acre impoundment lake, which is stocked regularly with rainbow, golden rainbow, brook, and brown trout. Due to its high elevation, Spruce Knob Lake water stays cool and is an excellent trout fishery from the

spring and into the summer.

Spruce Knob Lake is more remote than other West Virginia trout waters, but it has gained a reputation as an excellent trout-fishing waterway. It is a pro-

ductive trout fishery, and a number of trophy-sized trout have been recorded from these waters. Anglers are able to launch and fish from small boats or kayaks or fish from the shore.

# **Trout Catching Methods**

trout are among the most popular fish for anglers to target in North America. Trout always put up a good fight, are abundant by both stocking and natural reproduction, and are pretty tasty when anglers decide to keep them.

There are 3 main species of trout anglers chase, and they all have somewhat similar characteristics. The Rainbow, Brook, and Brown

Behind bass and possibly panfish, Trout are the most common variations. There is also the wildcard steelhead, which is classified as a rainbow trout that spends time in the ocean or Great Lakes before returning to freshwater or smaller tributaries to spawn. In doing so these rainbows gain a silvery tint to them, hence their name. This habit, most commonly seen in salmon, breeds a size and toughness in the normally smaller bows which makes them living legends among trout anglers.

Where To Find The Trout header trout winter

Trout are most often found in cold water and often live in moving water as they run up and down

essible food sources for wild- they can grow to massive size life, you can likely find them in and put up fights usually reserved the woods where you'd also find for the ocean. These trout can be bears, bobcats, and other fishing found feeding on smaller fish in wildlife. The more remote the river or lake, the more likely you are to find some trout swimming through their waters. This makes trout fishing some of the more active gamefishing any angler can do, where it almost crosses a line into hunting or tracking.

Trout are also abundant deep in some of the great lakes, where

the depths of the lake, or more commonly during the salmon spawn, raiding their beds. Finding out where trout are stocked is simply and easy, and a week or two after a stock is always a great time to try your hand.

What Fishing Gear To Use When **Trout Fishing** 

Since rainbow trout grow to about 12 inches, you are safe even with ultralight tackle. A standard trout fishing rig would include a spinning reel, 4-8 lb test fluorocarbon line, and a light or ultralight action rod.



There are two big rules to remember when trout fishing:

1. Powerbait will only work on stocked trout (most likely)

2. Most trout over a foot long cut flies and insects out of their diet. These won't make or break the bite, but they will affect the type continue to the next page

you hook into.


Powerbait (or trout marshmallows, or any dough bait substitute to imitate pellets) is simply not a good choice for natives. Stocked trout grow up in hatcheries and on farms where they are fed pellets. Dough baits like Powerbait are created solely to imitate those pellets in sight, texture, and scent. If you are fishing for natives, they likely have no idea what that glob of dough floating in front of them is. While you may get a bite out of curiosity, it is unlikely that they continue to the next page

are conditioned to eat those pellets and will lay off your line.

If you're looking for BIG trout (steelhead or larger adults of the bows, browns, and brooks), avoid fly, mayfly and tiny-haired imitators. While they may snack on zooplankton, flies or other tiny insects occasionally, they almost exclusively eat smaller fish, worms, shrimp, and larger insects when they are over 1 foot in length. To imitate those common trout meals when trout fishing, here's what you should throw.

The Best Lures & Rigs For Trout Fishing

To imitate the creatures trout eat, there are a few main types of lures. If you're going trout fishing, make sure to pack at least one of each of these. And, if you're looking to purchase a gift for a trout angler, consider these as top of mind:

Crankbaits may not be your first choice when fishing for trout, but big trout will hit a crank as large as 1/3 or eve 1/2 of their size. With sharp teeth like trout have, it doesn't take much to suffice for a snack for them, and they have no



A small hook rigged with live bait, realistic soft plastics, or artificial fish putty-like will catch you trout all day long, especially if you're targeting stocked on unpressured fish. To do this, rig a bobber mear the depth you think fish are feeding, and present your bait that wat. By suspending your presentation, you'll be able to catch fish roaming in the middle of the water. In shallow water,

bottom with light-powered spinning rods at stocked ponds. I met an angler in Arizona fishing this exact method one time, he thought that stocked fish eat pellets, and while most pellets get eaten right away, a few might sink to the bottom and just lay there until a trout gobbles them up. He cast out small putty-balls made from trout dough deep into the middle of the pond and caught most of his keeper fish that way.

Split shotting 1-2 small weights about a foot above a small Aberdeen hook rigged with live bait is a great way to fish trout in current. Cast your rig out and slowly bring it back with the current while hopping your bait along the bottom. Keep the rod tip high, and don't let the bait rest on the bottom for too long to prevent snags.

2) Fly Fishing Gear

Trout are the most targeted fish that fly anglers chase after and their love for catching rainbows, browns, and brook trout has created its own unique culture, industry, and overall look. Fly anglers often fish wadeable creeks, rivers, and streams in the pursuit of fish, and in these places, their ability to subtly present lures oftentimes will outproduce the tools that a conventional angler might carry. Post Fly is a fishing company



that provides a monthly fly fishing box to help anglers get better equipped for chasing fish in their area. It makes fly fishing for trout approachable and fun!

3) Inline Spinners

Spinners and rooster tails are the bread and butter of trout anglers nationwide. Easily changed in and out on a swivel, they get bit anywhere in a lake, but their flapping blades are suited to add flash to a river current.

4) Soft Plastics Bugs & Crickets Grasshoppers, beetles, crickets, and other larger bugs end up falling into the rivers and streams of trout all the time. They're used to seeing them as easy snacks. Try drowning live grasshoppers or using imitators to float in the current.

Tubes or grubs imitate zooplankton and other easy snacks all fish snack on. Truth be told they don't look much like anything swim-



ming in the water. But truth be told they get bit a LOT. So, keep them in the tackle box.

Trout love to feast on smaller baitfish, especially bigger trout. The best way to trigger strikes

when they are up feeding on baitfish is a paddletail swimbait that can disrupt the column.

Obviously, live worms get bit by just about every fish and this is one of the most simple trout catching techniques. Some downsized soft plastic worms are great choices for trout. Bright colors that can be detected in moving water are a plus when fishing rivers.

5) Crankbaits

When we talk about crankbaits for trout, it is not the same traditional form of crankbaits you would throw at a bass. While bass fishing with crankbaits, you are imitating common forage of baitfish such as shad, bluegill, or perch. Lipped baits you would throw while trout fishing can imitate anything from minnows and baitfish to creatures such as crickets, grasshoppers, or beetles. These are the types of bugs that fall from branches and bushes into cold water creeks and streams, where trout are lingering for an easy meal. 6) Spoons

Flashy spoons, especially those tipped with feathers and sometimes even wax worms, are effective for trout all year long. They thrive, however, in colder weather when the bite slows down. Their flashiness can annoy and entice into a bit bite.

7) Powerbait & Salmon Eggs

Essentially any dough bait will be called "power bait" by a trout angler, just like every tissue is called a kleenex and every disc is called a frisbee. If there are stocked trout anywhere in the vicinity, it's worth having a few col-



ors of power bait to ball up onto a hook and give it a go.

Trout are notorious scavengers, raiding spawning beds of other fish constantly to feed on their eggs. Cut one belly open and you'll see tons of roe. Thread a few onto a size 6 hook and they will treat it like a buffet.


