




First Deer



2009 Total Deer Harvest Report

Preliminary counts of game checking tags indicate West Virginia hunters harvested a total of 154,524 white-tailed deer during the recently completed bucks-only, antlerless, muzzleloader, archery and youth/Class Q deer seasons, according to West Virginia Division of Natural Resources Director Frank Jezioro. This year's total harvest was 5.5 percent below the 2008 deer harvest of 163,603. Hunters killed a total of 63,590 bucks during the firearms deer season, 54,617 antlerless-season deer, 27,558 archery-season deer and 8,759 muzzleloader-season deer during the 2009 deer hunting seasons.

Antlerless Deer Season

The 2009 antlerless deer season, which includes the youth/Class Q deer hunts, was 2.8 percent below 2008 but 4.8 percent above the five-year average of 52,095. "It is important to note that a major component of our agency's deer management strategy is to regulate the harvest of antlerless deer in individual counties to raise or lower the future deer population," said Jezioro. The top 10 counties for antlerless deer harvests are: Lewis (2,565), Jackson (2,509), Preston (2,419), Mason (2,238), Ritchie



(2,098), Wood (2,068), Harrison (1,946), Monroe (1,731), Braxton (1,654) and Hardy (1,612).

Muzzleloader Deer Season

The 2009 muzzleloader harvest of 8,759 was 150 deer more than the 2008 harvest but 7.4 percent below the five-year average of 9,464. The top 10 counties for muzzleloader deer harvests are: Preston (450), Lewis (408), Jackson (339), Braxton (331), Randolph (299), Mason (290), Wood (282), Grant (267), Harrison (264) and Ritchie (254). Archery Deer Season

The bowhunters' take of 27,558 deer was 12 percent below the 2008 harvest of 31,408 but four percent above the five-year average harvest of 26,465. The top 10 counties for archery deer harvests are:



Randolph (1,077), Preston (1,048), Kanawha (930), Nicholas (840), Wood (833), Jackson (815), Greenbrier (813), Fayette (743), Raleigh (731) and Logan (728).

tions. I will use actual questions (in their own words) from some of the emails I get along with some of the "Ask a Pro" questions directed to me from several internet sites I write for.

Question#1 – Creighton from Georgia asks:

Hello again Roger, I had another question pop into my head. When fishing tournaments every fish counts. With this, say you hook a fish that you know is going to be a good keeper/upgrade or what you may call it, and you lose him on the way in. How long could it be before that fish may bite again, and if so would it go after same bait, and return to same cover as before? As always thanks for everything Creighton

This is a question that gets asked by many anglers. My answer to this question is yes; sometimes the bass will hit the same bait again right away and sometimes later on the same day. For example, I have worked a certain bait around a piece of structure in clear water and watched a bass come up and hit it, then when setting the hook I somehow missed it and made another cast (with the same bait) and the bass hit the bait a second time and I landed it. There are also times where I would be fishing an area with certain baits and hooked



the bass, but reeling it in the line would snap and I would loose it. Later on the same day I would go back to the same place and catch the same bass with the bait I used earlier still in its mouth. A bass has a very short memory span and will definitely hit twice or even a third time on the same day!

Question#2 – Butch from Ohio asks:

I have a problem getting a hook set with a weedless jig the guard seems to be to stiff any solution THANK YOU

I have had this problem myself for years and finally came up with actually two solutions. First, I found that if you use a wide gap hook on a weedless jig it will help catch more bass. Secondly, I will take a weedless jig right out of the package and take half of the weed guard strands and cut them off as low to the base of the weed guard as possible. This will allow much more flexibility

with the weed guard and will definitely give you a better chance of setting the hook!

Question#3 – Glen from Africa asks:

Coach, I am a missionaries son here in africa and fish some of the local tournaments. I have seen lots of bass caught on a torpedo but am having a hard time catching them any suggestions?

A Torpedo falls into actually two categories, the first one being a "top water bait" and the second being a "prop bait". There is really no right or wrong way to use (or pres-

12 Miles West From I 79 entation) that always seems to work the best for me by; casting the bait, as soon as it hits the water I will give it a very light twitch and just let it set for a moment. After letting it set for a moment I will again give 1 or 2 more light twitch's letting it sit again for about 10 to 15 seconds all the way back to where I'm standing. Whether the fish or active or inactive this seems to work great for me. This works for all types of prop baits and not just the Torpedo!

fishing school understand what is really needed and what is not really practical to buy depending on their affordability. For example, does an angler need a dozen different rods to fish with using all the different baits? Or, does an angler need the most expensive reels money can buy? Let me suggest to you that I teach "Smart Spending" to my students. To give you an idea of what I mean is that I have put together one box that consists of a top compartment with 3 slide out plastic boxes which I can take anywhere in the United States and within the contents of the box I can catch bass on any body of water at just about any time with what's in the box. far as rods and reels go, it is nice to have several different rods for each technique or application, but I can get by with just 3 different rods for all the different baits that are mostly used by anglers today (I would just have to re-tie a lot, but you can do it.) As far as reels go, it depends on the type(s) of reels you use i.e. baitcaster, spinning, or spincast reels. There are distinct advantages and disadvantages on these different reels, but it's what you can afford and simply getting use to any one of them. Just remember like anything else, you usually get what continue to the next page

you pay for as far as quality goes. I have found that there are a handful of baits that can cover top water, in between, and bottom fishing that won't cost you an arm and a leg to get started, and one step better, these baits are universal. These baits have worked anywhere from California to Texas, and from Minnesota to the East Coast with great success!

Question#5 – Bryant from Florida I have an Abu Garcia ambassador black max-L and I have been messing with the knob and I still backlash a lot any tips

I'm afraid to say that I haven't known any angler (ever) using a baitcaster reel that never backlashes it. The whole secret to using a baitcaster is thumb control along with a little adjustment to the bait that you use. Most baitcaster reels have a plate covering the side of the reel (usually opposite of the handle side) that when taking it off you can see little rollers on the bottom of the spool. I will always take the rollers and move them out one click, this helps slow down the free spooling motion a bit. Next, I will

adjust the magnetic break on the outside of the same plate after putting it back on the reel about 75% on. This will also help slow the free spooling motion of the reel by giving it some resistance. Now, the next step I feel is the most important in preventing backlashes when casting bait. After you tie on the bait, push the thumb bar (releasing the bait) and tighten the knob (break) on the side of the handle as the bait falls. You want to tighten the knob (or break) so that it stops free falling but just tight enough that if you twitch the tip of your rod the bait will only drop a few inches, and that's it! You will find that using a baitcaster will be a lot more fun and you should spend more time fishing with it than trying to pull out them nasty backlashes.

Baitcaster reels are by far more accurate, easier to use, than spinning and spincast reels and a must for certain types of bass fishing like Flippin' & Pitchin'. I never have had a student that I haven't taught or shown how to use a baitcaster reel while attending my 3-day bass fishing school. You will find that

most, not all!, but most pros use baitcaster reels for most of their bass fishing techniques. Now, the next times you get a backlash just remember the simple adjustments along with thumb control and you should have much more fun. Then when you do backlash (yes, it will happen but not as often) you can call it a "Professional Override" don't that sound so much nicer that that ugly word BACKLASH?





Secret To Catching Channel Cats


Throughout West Virginia, numerous waters support healthy populations of channel catfish, one of the most popular sport fish in America. However, in many of our waters the fish are underutilized. Channel cats, besides being prized table food, are highly successful because they eat various foods of animal and plant origin. For an example about every channel cat fisherman has caught fish with stomachs stuffed with aquatic vegetation the fish scraped

In addition to eating a variety of foods, channel cats have highly developed receptors covering their skin and barbells and these are used to locate food. There is evidence that the fish can detect smells at concentrations of a few parts per million at considerable distances from sources. When an enticing smell arouses a fish's attention it searches for the source similar to a surface-to- air missile seeking an enemy aircraft.

When asked about the preferred bait for catching channel catfish the invariable answer in West Virginia is fresh chicken livers. Many fish are taken on livers, and Mountain

What many West Virginians may not know is that in areas of the country renown for channel catfish fishing there are baits which consistently work better than chicken livers. acteristic which is a smell that one character characterized as something which repels veteran cadaver dogs.

The baits are paste-like and most have high fat contents. On cool days the fats harden to make it more difficult to apply bait to bait holders, but with use of products including Hot Hands the baits can be warmed up for easier application. Regarding bait holders, there are numerous types on the market including those resembling rubber tubing with round holes cut into them, holders on which bait is deposited, holders which resemble plastic cages and ones designed for baits to be injected into. Similar to most fishing situations, a holder which works best on all days for all water conditions does not exist.

and a fisherman should experiment on trips to determine which one works best on a particular day. For unknown reasons, on some days channel cats even exhibit color preferences for holders.

The recommended rigging for a bait holder for flowing water is to have it on a leader tied to a barrel swivel and to use an egg sinker on the other side of the swivel to reduce resistance when a channel cat bites. Also, it is best to use egg sinkers small as possible for existing water conditions. The recommended approach is to begin with one-half ounce sinkers. In lakes, the proffered approach is to use leaders on holders and to use a bobber while continue to the next page

keeping the holders about two feet off the bottom. By keeping them above the bottom, smells from bait form a cone-like pattern channel cats can detect easier.

Regarding stink baits to use, the recommended procedure is to try different ones to find which works Through experimentation best. with baits and holders, gaining knowledge about where and when to fish, and water conditions which provide the best fishing, a fisherman can be in the winner's circle. That means being among the ten

percent who catch ninety percent of the fish. In West Virginia waters it is common for skilled fishermen who use stink baits to catch more "keeper" channel catfish in a day than the average fisherman catches in a life time. Additionally, experienced fishermen know that too many fishing products on the market are designed to catch fishermen, not fish. Therefore, when something is purchased which does not work, toss it aside to find something to aid in getting more channel cats into the ice chest.

Hurrican Lake Resumes Stocking

Hurricane Lake in Putnam County is again being stocked with trout beginning in January, according to Curtis I. Taylor, Chief of the Wildlife Resources Section of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. The lake will be stocked once in January and again in March.

Hurricane Lake was stocked with trout until 2002, when road construction and lake renovations caused stockings to cease. The lake is in a very populated area, and fishing pressure is expected to be heavy, as it was when previously stocked.

Hurricane Lake was inadvertently omitted from the 2010 Fishing Regulations as being on the stocking schedule.

Black Bear Harvest

West Virginia hunters harvested 1,828 black bears during the combined 2009 archery and firearms seasons, according to Chris Ryan, Supervisor of Game Management Services for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. The preliminary harvest data for the combined seasons in 2009 is the second highest harvest on record behind only 2008.

"Multiple factors contributed to this most recent bear harvest," said Ryan. "West Virginia has a tremendous bear population that allows for a variety of different hunting opportunities. The poor statewide mast conditions allowed archery hunters to better pattern bear movements as the bruins were looking for concentrated food sources. However, poor mast conditions and a larger than normal December snowfall pushed bears into their winter dens, thereby making them unavailable to gun hunters."

Hunters took a record 987 bears during the 2009 archery season. This was the first time in history that the archery harvest topped 800, let alone reaching the 900 mark. Biologists predicted that this would be a record bow harvest because of the statewide mast conditions and the



biologists have demonstrated a direct relationship between mast conditions and bear gun harvests. The poor mast conditions coupled with the larger than normal snowfall and reduced hunting opportunities resulted in a predictable lower gun harvest in 2009. Top five counties were Randolph (112), Fayette (86), Pocahontas (74), Pendleton (70), and Raleigh (58).



Additional Deer With CWD

Preliminary test results indicate the Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) agent was present in 16 hunter-harvested deer collected in Hampshire County during the 2009 deer firearms hunting season.

"As part of our agency's ongoing CWD monitoring effort, samples were collected from 1,091 hunter-harvested deer brought to game checking stations in Hampshire County and one station near the southern Hampshire County line in Hardy County," noted Frank Jezioro, Director for the W.Va. Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR).

The 16 CWD positive deer included one 4.5 year-old doe, one 2.5 year-old doe, one 1.5 year-old buck, 10 2.5 year-old bucks, and three 3.5 year-old bucks. Thirteen of the latest positive deer were harvested within the Hampshire Coun-

ty CWD Containment Area (i.e., that portion of Hampshire County located North of U.S. Route 50). However, three were located outside the containment area but still within Hampshire County. The area in Hampshire County from which CWD has been detected continues to expand, and the number of infected deer detected this year is 2.5 times more than last year.

CWD has now been detected in a total of 62 deer in Hampshire County (i.e., two road-killed deer, one in 2005 and one in 2008; four deer collected by the WVDNR in 2005; five deer collected by the WVDNR in 2006; one hunter-harvest deer taken during the 2006 deer season; three deer collected by the WVDNR in 2007; six hunter-harvested deer taken during the continue to the next page



Fall Turkey Harvest Increase

Preliminary figures for the 2009 fall turkey hunting season show a harvest of 1,244 turkeys. This is slightly higher than the 1,206 turkeys checked in during the 2008 fall season. The eastern Mountain Region of the state reported a fall turkey harvest increase, with District 3 mountain counties up 16 percent and District 4 mountain counties up 20 percent. The fall turkey harvest declined 10 percent in the northern counties of District 1 and declined 15 percent in the eastern

panhandle counties of District 2. The top five counties for fall turkey harvests were Monroe (116), Nicholas (114), Greenbrier (99), Preston (82) and Mason (81).

Wildlife biologists had predicted a similar to slightly higher fall harvest based on good brood counts in the traditional fall counties of the Mountain Region and poor food conditions in other parts of the state. These conditions tend to concentrate birds in large flocks, making them more susceptible to hunters.

"The 2009 fall turkey harvest came in as predicted based upon our field reports and data," reported Paul Johansen, Assistant Chief in Charge of Game Management. "Less than ideal weather conditions occurred in some portions of the state during the first week of the season, and this may have hampered hunters," Johansen noted. "However, poor mast conditions served to concentrate birds making them more available to hunters throughout the season."


