How To Fish For Crappie In Shallow Water

Minnows are the most popular summertime bait for anglers fishing a tight line off docks or spider rigging in boats. Since a crappie's appetite is voracious during the summer, I select larger minnows (sometimes bigger than 3 inches) for my bait. I prefer using 2/0 and 3/0 hooks because the bigger hook is easier to remove from a crappie and the fish don't swallow it as much as they do a smaller hook.


Jigs are also productive for summertime crappie. I use either a single 1/16-ounce jig for shooting docks or a double rig for vertically jigging above brush piles. The double rig consists of a 1/16-ounce jig spaced 18 inches above a 1/8-ounce jig at the end of my line.

How To Fish For Crappie In Deep Water

The shallow pattern consists of dipping minnows with a long pole and slip-bobber system in timber along fence rows and tree lines on the main lake or creek channel. You can catch these fish less than 10 feet deep and sometimes even as shallow as 2 feet. The slip-bobber system allows you to adjust your bobber up or down to find the magic depth in which the crappie are holding. Use number 2 or 4 hooks and pinch on a couple of number 5 split shots about 2 to 3 inches above the hook. Keeping the weight close to the minnow will restrict its movement to prevent hang-ups in the heavy cover. Summertime Crappie Fishing: Deep Water

The deep-water pattern works best in timber along main lake bluffs and channel swings during the hottest part of summer.. The same slip-bobber rig used for catching shallow crappie also

2nd Record Blue Catfish This Year

LEON, W.Va. — A Wednesday morning on the water turned out to be an epic adventure for an Ohio angler on the Kanawha River in West Virginia.

Steven Price, of Lancaster, Ohio, anchored up on a spot between Point Pleasant and the Winfield Lock and Dam where he has had success hunting for big catfish. He started his day with rods baited up with cut shad around 7:30 a.m.

"About 10 minutes into the trip my rod bent all the way over the

back of the boat. Four or five minutes into the fight I'm thinking this thing is 40 to 50 pounds. But he turned and went right into the structure and got me hung up," he In about 15 minutes, Deja-vu. told MetroNews.

The record catch was his third bite of the day. Price also caught this 56 pounder and lost one he believes was in the same class on his first bite of the day.

It was a disappointment and Price admitted he didn't expect he would hook up with one that

big again. But, it was early and he was on the water so he rebaited and cast his lines back into the water to see what would happen.

"The rod goes down on the back of the boat, I pick it up and it's another big one. He came up and rolled and I got him into the boat and that fish was 56 pounds. I was thinking man what a day!" he explained.







New State Record-Carp Caught

SOUTH CHARLESTON, WV — West Virginia lakes and streams continue to produce both trophy-sized game fish and record catches. On Saturday, May 7, Ayden Minick of Mt. Pleasant, PA, caught and released a new state record common carp while fishing from the bank of Summersville Lake in Nicholas County.

Minick's record fish was 41.2 inches long and weighed 45.2 pounds. The trophy carp surpassed the previous West Virginia length record of 41.0 inches caught in 1988 by Charles Cook at Stonecoal Lake. However, Minick's fish did not beat the current weight

places can be found if you search for them. Not everyone lives near a major water system, but that doesn't make any difference. You can still go fishing and have fun.

Private waters are around and are available if you handle things properly. Always ask — individuals and businesses alike — and never fish anywhere without permission. Most everyone will cooperate if they believe you're a responsible person. That's especially true if you make sure they know you're working with new anglers and kids. Most people like that.


We now know how to get started finding a place to fish. But you still have to know where to fish in that place. Let me say that every fish I've ever caught was on or near some change, or an area that is different somehow from the surrounding water. It might be a depth change, a rock, a stump, a tree laying in the water or even a dock. Do not forget what I just

said. It might be the most important thing that's in this column. Change is good. Different is good.

You should always fish around incoming water too, no matter if it's a river, a stream, a creek or simply a ditch. And, that reminds me of something else. Fish love current. When you find current it's usually a great place to fish, especially when the water is warm.

Another thing to keep in mind is that fish like vegetation that's growing in the water. When it's green it puts oxygen in the water and it gives them a place to hide and ambush their prey. It's a rare patch of weeds or pads that doesn't hold something that'll pull back on your line.





The last thing I want to mention is, if you're fishing a creek, stream or river, always fish its bends and anywhere else where it changes direction. Those spots have been consistent producers for me.




