When the water is 50 degrees and lower, bass move as little as possible to conserve energy. Lures reeled in slowly, like a jig & trailer, work better. Chase baits (spinnerbaits & crankbaits) will not catch many fish.

Getting To Know WV Snakes

Getting to know wildlife in West and Timber Rattlesnake. Although Virginia is another reason to appreciate the beauty the landscape provides. Among some of these animals are snakes and other reptiles. These members of the reptile class play a vital role in the balance of nature. Their colorful and complex life histories are fascinating and give little justification for the apprehension felt by so many.

The fear of being bitten causes many persons to senselessly kill any snake they see. Yet, of the 20 species of snakes found in the Mountain State, only two are venomous, the Northern Copperhead

most venomous snake bites in West Virginia are from copperheads, no fatalities from copperheads have been recorded in over 30 years. From 1969 to 1992 only four people in the Mountain State have died from rattlesnake bites while in the wild. Bee stings. cows and horses caused 15 times as many deaths as snakes. Up to one-half of venomous snake bites result in no venom being injected. If, however, you are bitten by a venomous snake, see a doctor or go to a hospital immediately.

Their main prey consists of rodents and small mammals, which they subdue using hemotoxic venom. They are members of the Pit Viper family, for they possess

> Some of West Virginia's snakes are very common, such as the Eastern Gartersnake and Black Ratsnake, and can be found all over (even in backyards). Others, such as the Cornsnake and Northern Pinesnake, have only been documented a few times over the years. Always be on the lookout in case one shows up in your area. Snakes have a way of bringing about a certain intense fear in

Nuisance Bear Activity Prevention

SOUTH CHARLESTON, WV — To prevent nuisance bear activity around the state, the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is asking residents to secure or remove food, pet food, scraps, trash and other bear attractants around their homes.

"Deliberately feeding a black bear is illegal in West Virginia, but people tend to forget that unintentionally feeding a bear can also cause serious problems for humans, their property and our state animal," said Colin Carpenter, black bear project leader for the WVDNR. "Once a bear gets a taste for human food, they become more of a nuisance and often have to be humanely killed for safety reasons."

The peak of nuisance bear activity in West Virginia occurs in May and June when natural food sources are scarce. High-energy foods, such as serviceberries, blackberries, raspberries and blueberries, do not become available until later in the summer, which is why hungry black bears can be found in residential areas in the spring.



> Tips For Preventing Nuisance Bear Activity

> Keep garbage secure in a garage or storage building and only place cans out for collection on the morning of pick-up, not the night before.

- Seal food scraps that produce an odor in a plastic bag before placing them in the trash.
- Don't place food scraps in a compost pile during the summer.
- Don't let outside pet food stay out overnight. Take down bird feeders and clean and store them until late fall.
- Store livestock feed in bearproof containers or inside a secure building.
- Keep bears out of beehives and chicken houses by installing an electric fence.

Feeding bears and wildlife in general should be avoided. Coming into contact with wild animals can transmit diseases, lead to in-

creased predation, result in habitat destruction around the feeding site, cause ethical concerns and harm the animal's overall health. Carpenter says following practical and common-sense recommendation for reducing human-bear conflicts is the best way to make sure that state's animals remain wild.

Black Bear Harvest

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. — West Virginia hunters harvested 2,756 black bears during the combined 2021 arc crease compared to the 2020 harvest of 3,541 bears.

The decreased black bear harvest can be attributed to abundant mast production, which was 61 percent above 2020 numbers and 8 percent above the long term average. The 2021 Mast Survey and Hunting Outlook predicted a lower archery/crossbow harvest compared to 2020 and a decreased firearms harvest over the levels observed in 2020. Both predictions came true.

"Historically, abundant mast yields result in a decreased bow and crossbow harvest and an increased December firearms harvest," said Colin Carpenter, Black Bear Project Leader for the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources. "Abundant food in the fall makes bears harder to pattern for bow/crossbow hunters but keeps bears from denning early for the December season."

Overall, the 2021 harvest decreased during the September-October archery/crossbow and buck gun seasons, but increased during the December gun season.

Hunters killed 639 bears during the first segment of the 2021 archery/crossbow season (Sept. 25-Nov. 21). There were 342 bears taken with vertical bows and 297 taken with crossbows. The top five counties were Fayette (55), McDowell (52), Nicholas (42), Logan (40) and Wyoming (38).

Firearms hunters harvested 2,117 bears during 2021. Hunters took 780 bears in September and October (37 bears during the concurrent antlerless deer/bear season, four during the youth, class Q/ QQ, XS season), 435 during the concurrent buck-gun bear season and 900 during the traditional December season. Two bears were harvested during the fourth Mountaineer Heritage Season (two muzzleloader). The top five counties were Pocahontas (186), pound rainbow trout.

Nicholas (167), Randolph (161), Boone (157) and Pendleton (137).

Archery In The Schools Returns

SOUTH CHARLESTON, WV — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources announced on Tuesday the results of its first in-person Archery in the Schools state tournament in two years along with the event's top shooters and school-based teams.

More than 600 students participated in the tournament and nearly 2,000 attendees were present at the Charleston Coliseum and Convention Center on Saturday, March 26.

"The Archery in the Schools program is so important to a lot of kids and being able to meet in person again after two long years really made this year's tournament special," Chris Scraggs, who coordinates the Archery in the Schools program for the WVDNR. "We want to thank everyone who participated in the program this year and extend a big congratulations to all our teams and students that placed in the state tournament."

More than 1,300 students from 76 schools in West Virginia par-





ticipated in the state's qualifier rounds. The top seven elementary, middle and high school teams and the top 15 male and top 15 female elementary, middle and high school students were invited to participate in the state tournament on Saturday.



The bass tournament competition Scott created rewarded anglers who caught the heaviest limits of bass in the three- or four-day events, which served as the proving grounds for rapid advancements in bass boats, outboard engines, fishing tackle, lures and electronics. Everyday anglers began purchasing whatever the bass pros were using, spawning a

massive bass fishing industry that today has an economic impact in excess of \$125 billion per year and employs more than 800,000 people nationwide.

Before Scott began pursuing his dream of organizing America's bass anglers, the sport was a laidback, mainly southern pastime

that was largely overlooked by the trout-focused national outdoor media. To serve B.A.S.S. members and to publicize the tournament trail, Scott launched Bassmaster Magazine, which the New York Times described as "the Bible of Bass Fishing," and continue to the next page

which ultimately would be delivered to 650,000 B.A.S.S. members monthly.

In 1984, he and then-Bassmaster Editor Bob Cobb created The Bassmasters TV show, which attracted more than 1 million viewers weekly on The Nashville Network. Aired today on Fox Sports, the program is one of the longest-running and most-watched fishing shows in history.

In 1972, he debuted the "Don't Kill Your Catch" campaign and mandated that all tournament competitors' boats feature an aerated livewell to keep their bass alive.


"I didn't invent catch and release," Scott acknowledge, "but we did make it popular in bass fishing, and that changed the sport in so many ways. We preached that a bass is too valuable to be caught only once. We helped fishermen learn how great it felt to catch a 5- or 6-pound bass and then lean over and let it go and watch it swim away, hopefully to be caught again."

As a result, the catch-and-release



ethic caught on so well that more than 90% of all bass anglers today release all or most of the bass they saded against industrial pollution catch.

of America's waterways. In 1970 and '71, Scott filed some 200 anti-pollution lawsuits, drawing national attention to declining water quality and contributing significantly to passage of the Clean Water Act of 1972.

He was an early advocate of bass fisheries research, and he campaigned zealously for passage of the federal Wallop-Breaux Sportfish Restoration Amendment of 1984. When the bill stalled in Congress, Scott's friendship with then-Vice President George H.W. Bush helped ensure enactment of the amendment. As a result, approximately \$375 million in sportfish restoration allocations

are provided annually to state fisheries agencies for management, aquatic education and public access projects.

Few individuals have had a more positive impact on boating safety than Scott. Early on, he began requiring tournament competitors to wear personal flotation devices whenever boating, and he convinced manufacturers to make emergency shut-off devices — "kill switches" — standard features on motorboats. In 1994, he was instrumental in passing the comprehensive Boating Safety Reform Act in Alabama, which became the first state to require that boat drivers pass a written exam and obtain a boat operator's license.

In recognition of his efforts, President Jimmy Carter appointed Scott to the U.S. Coast Guard's National Boating Safety Advisory Council, and in 2002, he was inducted into the National Boating Safety Hall of Fame.

Scott's was a true rags-to-riches story. He was born in Montgomery, Ala., on Aug. 24, 1933, and grew up there during the depths of the Great Depression. His father operated an ice cream cart and his mother worked as a hairdresser to support the family, which grew to include Ray, his brother and three continue to page 19

uncles — all living in a one-bedroom home. Scott contributed to the family treasury by delivering groceries on his bicycle, mowing lawns and selling peanuts at baseball games.

After a decade in the life insurance business, Scott had a vision that he might be the one to elevate the national profile of bass fishing to be, as he said, "on par with golf" and worthy of television exposure. That year, 1967, he quit his job and began organizing the first major national bass fishing tournament, the All American at Beaver Lake, Ark. The event was successful enough for Scott to begin holding tournaments at other reservoirs in the South and to launch B.A.S.S. and Bassmaster early in 1968.

His brainchild, the annual Bass-

master Classic world championship, grew from two dozen competitors and about that many spectators at Lake Mead, Nev., in 1971, to become the biggest event in sportfishing over the next half-century. Today, the Classic and related events such as the Classic Outdoor Expo record

more than 100,000 fishing fans each year.

He sold B.A.S.S. to an investment group including his executive vice president, Helen Sevier, and other employees in 1986, but he continued to serve as emcee of the Classic for several more years. He later became a consultant and a popular spokesman for numerous companies in the fishing industry, and he launched a successful hunting industry enterprise to market deer feed and related products through his Whitetail Institute.

After a half-century of helping to grow and shape the sportfishing industry worldwide, Scott retired to his farm near Pintlala, Ala., where he remained mostly out of the public eye in the years prior to his death.





Hunters can choose to complete the survey in a brief telephone interview or online. The survey is scheduled to start in May and will be completed before the end of July.

Understanding hunters' concerns about CWD may help the WVD-NR more effectively communicate with hunters and identify public needs, such as providing more information about CWD and increasing voluntary testing of deer harvested in CWD-positive counties in the future.

Spring Channel Catfish

The Robins begin to show and the and sharpen their jig heads for songbirds begin to sing signaling the coming of spring and the end der rigging some tuffies along of winter. For the hunter, it means strutting gobblers. For the angler, it means warming waters and the beginning of a great season of great fun and fresh fillets. Here be just as good for channel cats as are a few tips on how to catch early spring channel catfish.

Most anglers I know begin April is a month of activities. to prepare their crappie poles some deep brush jigging or spicreek channels leading to known spawning grounds or sunken stake beds. This is a great time for some cruising crappies but it can old man winter loses ground.

> This time of year can be deceiving as the air temperature rises the catfish angler can't wait to get on the water. The problem is that the water takes a while to warm even with bright sunny days and warmer weather. The important thing with early spring catfishing is the

temp. Finding the warmer water on any lake will be the focus and just a few degrees can make all the difference.

Locating Early Spring Channel Catfish

Look for temp changes in shallow coves. The larger the area of shallow water the quicker it will warm providing great catfish action. Water 1 to 4 feet is a great place to look as the springtime sun is drawn to the dark bottom of the lake causing the water to warm

quicker in these areas. I know it is tempting to fish deep when the water temps are so low but cat-fish do feed in these shallow areas as the water begins to warm. The warmer water stimulates the cold-blooded cats causing them to prowl but an even stronger motivator is the food found in these shallow coves in the spring.

In the winter there is a natural die-off of fish that occurs and if your lake has shad, which most successful catfish lakes do, then the amount of food floating below the surface of the lake can be extraordinary. This die-off provides catfish with a much-needed food source to begin the spawn that is nearing the warming of water.



Instinct will prevail and the catfish know that these windswept coves have trapped lots of dead fish from the winterkill and they do take advantage of this natural occurrence.

Wind to an angler can be a nuisance or a great ally. In the case continue to page 29



Best Bait For Channel Catfish

livers and where legal fresh bluegill fillets work great.

First scale the bluegill then fillet. The scales trap the smell of the meat and need to be removed. Some will argue that the smellier the bait the better. Fresh bait has always worked well for me and seems to attract the larger fish as well. I may be wrong, but I keep the stinky stuff out of my boat and stick to fresh or fresh frozen. I have caught fish on the rotten stuff but wasted a lot of time with missed strikes and smaller fish.

Since going to strictly fresh bait the number of bites dropped off, but the action on bigger fish increased. I waste little time on small fish. I spend my time fighting nice size channel catfish to the boat. Thirty minutes in one spot is continue to the next page



State Record Blue Catfish

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.VA.

— West Virginia's navigable rivers continue to produce hefty cat-fish, including one that recently broke the state record for weight.

On April 8, Cody Carver of Dry Branch, WV, caught and released a blue catfish that broke the state record for weight while fishing from a boat in the Marmet Pool of the Kanawha River. He was using cut shad for bait.

Carver's record fish was 45.51 inches long and weighed 61.28 pounds. The fish eclipsed the previous WV weight record of 59.74 pounds held by Mark Blauvelt. However, the length record of 50.15 inches held by Justin Goode still stands. Carver's record catch was measured by WVDNR hatchery manager Ryan Bosserman.

Anglers who believe they may have caught a state record fish should check the current records in the fishing regulations. Procedures for reporting a record catch also are included in the regulations.

State Record Musky

On Saturday March 18th, Luke King of Burnsville, West Virginia, cast himself into the record books. While casting a six inch hellhound lure, he caught and released a 55 1/16th inch long musky that weighed 51 pounds on certified scales. The musky is a true giant that tops the all time list of muskies caught in the mountain state.

King is no stranger to fishing for big muskies, having caught well over 1100 in his lifetime. It is without a doubt his passion. King fishes roughly ninety days a year in pursuit of muskies that stretch the tape well past the four foot mark.

For gear, he uses an 8'6" St. Croix mojo muskie extra heavy rod with a Daiwa lexa 300 and

Muskies of this size are almost certainly over a decade old. The previous state record, held by Chase Gibson, was aged at thirteen years old. King's musky has certainly spent a long time as the dominant predator, largely dining on populations of suckers and minnows.

King's fishing success has much to do with the fact that we are living in the heyday of muskie fishing in the mountain state. In 1952, Lester Hays caught a state record musky that was 52.5 inches and roughly 43 pounds from the Elk River at the Mouth of the Birch River. That record stood for forty-five years until Anna Marsh caught a larger one from Stonecoal Lake in 1997. Since then the record has been broken four times, most recently by Chase Gibson last year at Burnsville Lake.

Will King's muskie be beaten by a larger fish? It's possible but unlikely any time soon due to how high he raised the bar. Simply put, few muskie can obtain that size. A muskie is called the fish of a thousand casts. Luke King's musky is the fish of a thousand years.


