CHARLESTON, W.Va. - Ac- leased by the West Virginia Di-(WVDNR) today, hunters harvested 10,694 bearded turkeys during the spring gobbler season.

"Spring turkey season continues to be a valued tradition in West Virginia, where hunters have a strong commitment to wildlife conservation and responsible hunting practices," said WVDNR Director Brett McMillion. "We're encouraged by the strong participation this spring, especially from all of the youth hunters who bagged their bird during the twoday youth season."

Youth hunters harvested 682 turkeys (502 on Saturday and 180 on Sunday), which is a slight increase over the 601 birds that were taken in 2024. This year, the youth harvest made up 6.4% of the total harvest. Those numbers are included in the table with county totals.

Despite a strong showing from youth hunters, this year's total harvest was 8.2% below last year's harvest (11,650), 1,1% below the five-year average (10,812) and 8.7% below the 10-year average (11,709).

All six districts harvested fewer birds than last year. District 1 harvested the most birds (2,459) followed by District 6 (1,945), District 5 (1,889), District 4 (1,641), District 3 (1,547) and District Kanawha (306) counties.

How To Succeed On Pressured Lakes

This is the time of year when Another solution is beat the crowd bites can become a little more difficult.

It's important to understand the nature of bass. They are cold blooded, so during early spring, their metabolism is slower and the fish are less active. We want to make it easier for them to eat.

As the water warms up, they get more aggressive and will bite more active lure presentations. But, when the dog days of summer come along, bass' aggressiveness wanes. While fishing pressure can be a big factor, the bottom line is the fish aren't in the mood to eat as often when water temperatures soar.

I'm not saying they won't bite fast movers when in a summer funk. Oftentimes you have to trigger the reaction bite by working your bait faster or more erratic, such as with a crankbait like the Rapala DT Series or a big Mop Jig. Try changing speeds to trigger that reaction bite.

Aside from the reaction bite, you need to make the meal easier for them to eat. That means making precise casts and slowing down to match the fish's mood and the conditions.

lakes are getting pounded and to the best areas on the lake. When I'm going fun fishing, I want to be on the water by at least 30 minutes before sunrise. I'll have the aggressive fish caught before the crowd gets there.

> It also can pay to think outside the box. You can do that by using smaller – or larger – baits than the bass have been seeing.

> A change in location from the traditional pattern on a lake can make a huge difference too.

went to the bank and flipped a tube jig. He caught fish that had been ignored and not pressured.

A change-up also works on blueback herring lakes. During the summertime those fish are dialed in on the herring, so obvious baits are topwaters, swimbaits or jerkbaits that emulate the baitfish. Anglers know the best places,

and when the lake is being fished heavily, you have to wait in line to pull up on one of those spots.

When I won a Bassmaster Elite Series tournament at Clarks Hill Reservoir, I fished some of those spots but with an entirely different presentation. I fished a Buckeye Mop Jig, and I'm convinced they bit it because they hadn't seen it. While the herring were a popular target, the bass also were eating crawfish that the jig resembled.

So, when things get tough during summertime and lakes are heavily pressured, consider offering them a different look or fish less obvious places that get less pressure.

Summer In WV Fishing Spots

Whether you're looking for an easy-access lake for a family outing or a stream off-the-beatenpath for a weekend adventure, West Virginia has something for every angler. And with warm weather, consistent river flows and active fish populations, summer is the perfect time to cast a line in West Virginia's lakes and streams. Whether you're new to fishing, returning after a break or seeking to enhance your skills, the right techniques, knowledge of the target species and a sense of adventure can help you plan a successful and memorable fishing trip.

SUMMER FISHING TIPS AND BEST PRACTICES

Part of planning a successful summer fishing trip is understanding how seasonal and environmental factors affect fish behavior and adjusting your techniques accordingly.

As temperatures rise during summer, oxygen levels in water

drop, which causes fish in rivers to gather below riffles where water is more oxygenated or near the mouths of tributaries, which are cooler. In lakes, fish move to deeper, cooler areas with adequate oxygen. Targeting these areas can increase your chances of success.

Other general tips for successful summer fishing include:

Fish early in the morning or late in the evening and concentrate around riffles and tributary inflows.

Fish deeper waters in lakes or areas with vegetation and submerged structure.

Match your bait and technique to the species—worms under a bob-

Anglers of all ages can enjoy excellent fishing for bass, bluegill and crappie. The WVDNR also stocks catchable size channel catfish every June.

Fish Species Available: Largemouth Bass, Bluegill, Black Crappie, White Crappie, Channel Catfish

Best Techniques: Fish points, weedbed edges and brush. Use soft plastics, crankbaits and topwater lures for bass, especially in early morning and late evening hours.

Use jigs, spinners and live bait for crappie and bluegill. Topwater lures that imitate insects also are effective with bluegill. Use chicken liver, cut bait or nightcrawlers on the bottom for catfish. Target-

Best Techniques: Use flukes, senkos, swimbaits and most other soft plastic bait for largemouth bass. In vegetation, use topwater frogs. Use slip bobbers to catch crappie and bluegill near standing timber. Use chicken liver, cut bait or nightcrawlers on the bottom for catfish. Targeting catfish at night is particularly effective.

Regulations: The channel catfish daily limit is four. Only electric motors or non-motorized vessels are permitted. All black bass (smallmouth, largemouth and spotted) from 12 to 16 inches long must be returned to the water at once. Additionally, the daily creel limit for black bass is six.

BIG DITCH LAKE (WEBSTER COUNTY - DISTRICT 3)

Big Ditch Lake is a 65-acre mountain gem with shoreline access, a fishing pier and a peaceful setting. The lake holds a variety of species, such as largemouth bass



and panfish species. The WVD- crawlers on the bottom for cat-NR also stocks channel catfish fish. Targeting catfish at night is every June, and has stocked tiger musky, which can reach lengths of 40 inches, offering something exciting for every angler.

Fish Species Available: Largemouth Bass, Bluegill, Black and White Crappie, Channel Catfish, Tiger Musky

Best Techniques: Target weedbeds and brush for largemouth bass, bluegill and crappie using soft plastics, topwaters, jigs and worms. Use small jigs and spinners for crappie and bluegill. Use chicken liver, cut bait or night-

Flyfishing For Musky

By Nathan Rees

They say musky may be the fish of 10,000 cast but what you also don't hear ist hey can be the fish of 10,000 dollars! Only kidding of course.

Just like with all fish species and hobbies you can dive as deep down the rabbithole as you'd like. Musky fishing can be affordable and done on a budget or you can make it as complex and expensive as you'd like.

Having chased these fish for 20 years I'd like to lay out a few things I've learned over the many seasons on the water searching for them.

We will start off with the gear.

1. Rod and Reel: When diving into the sport look for a solid rod with a nice tip that can allow for a sturdy figure 8 (a technique I will explain in a littlewhile). A 10-12WT rod is recommended, and helps to turn over the large

flies. Pair the rod with a reel that falls within your budget. In the many years fishing for these fish I have never once used my reel to land one. For the most part all they do is act as a line holder.

 Line: look for a good intermediate sink or sink tip line in the 300-500 grain weight depending on the depth and current speed of the water you will be fishing. Shallower water go on the lighter end and deeper go a little heavier. 350-400 grain seems to be the sweet spot for most. I prefer a lighter line as they tend to give my flies the action I prefer.
 Flies: fly selection can be situational/seasonal. That being said

from 6" to 20+". When starting out I always recommend a good single Buford style fly and a fly with some articulation.

Streamers Bass & Musky

That happy medium for most of my flies falls in the 10-12" range. There are so many good fly tiers and patterns out there that it really is tough to go wrong. Just look for something with some buck tail, continue to the next page

something with some buck tail, feathers, and flash and you should be golden.

4. Miscellaneous: I recommend a good solid net (look into Catch Cam Nets), a nice set of long needle nose pliers, jaw spreaders, and Knipex bolt cutters for those times when the fish get hooked deep and that's the only option for a safe release.

Now that we got the basics of gear out of the way we can take a look at habitat/structure to target when you're out on the water. Below are a few of the areas I tend to focus on in the rivers and lakes of Appalachia:

• In lakes I will target standing timber, lay downs, rocky banks with chunk rock or boulders along them, weed beds, main lake points, deeperchannels with access to shallow water, and depending on time of the year and forage base sometimes it pays off to follow the bait wether that's

shallow or deep (it varies seasonally)

• In our rivers and streams I tend to focus on all forms of timber and lay downs wether it's shallow or deep. We also like to target mid river humps and sand bars. However with that being said most riv-

er/stream fish seem to come from the outside bending bank where the most current and flow channelizes the water making it deeper and a great place for a musky to ambush.

Finally I'd like to wrap up with a few tips and tricks I've learned over the years that have helped put some fish in the net.

• Always figure 8 (rod tip slightly in the water and make a 8 or infinity sign with the fly) after every cast or at the very minimum throw in a big half circle to see if you have something trialing the fly.

• If you get a fish to "follow" changing depth from shallow too deep with your figure 8 can often help trigger a strike.

• Roll casting your fly when it 49" musky.

gets hung up and using the weight of your sink tip to get it unstuck is an invaluable tip. It has saved me blowing out structure and spots many of times and it has also lay awaiting the opportunity to resulted in some wild reaction strikes from fish.

DNR Rule Changes

West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) today announced that changes to coyote, waterfowl and youth hunting regulations went into effect on May 19.

These changes, which were approved by the West Virginia Legislature during the 2025 regular session, include removing maximum caliber restrictions for night

CHARLESTON, W.Va. — The coyote hunting, increasing youth waterfowl hunter maximum age limits and providing clarification on adult supervision during special youth hunting seasons.

McMillion. "By expanding opportunities for youth hunters and supporting responsible practices, we're building the next generation of West Virginia sportsmen and women."

Small game hunters who hunt coyotes at night will no longer have a maximum caliber restriction. The WVDNR reminds hunters to always hunt safely and be aware of their target's location and what lies beyond. A safe backstop is important to avoid unintended injury to people and property.

The youth waterfowl season is now open to hunters 17 years of age or younger, expanding the previous age limit of 15 and under. The legislature also approved a change to make it clear an adult assisting a youth hunter during any special youth season may handle the hunter's firearm to provide safe handling advice and help. When assisting a youth hunter during a special youth season, the accompanying adult is still prohibited from carrying a firearm for the purpose of taking wildlife.

Youth hunters under the age of 15 who are not hunting on their own land or are participating in a special youth season must still be

accompanied by a licensed adult who is 18 years of age or older. The accompanying adult must remain close enough to the youth to provide guidance and assistance. Youth hunters ages 15-17 must comply with all applicable state

Leave Young Wildlife Alone

CHARLESTON, W.Va. - The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) today reminded members of the public to leave young wildlife alone, noting that handling wild animals often harms the animal, spreads disease and, when done without a permit, breaks the law.

"Watching wildlife is one of the many joys of being outdoors in West Virginia," said WVDNR Director Brett McMillion. "But for the safety of everyone and the preservation of our natural resources, it's always best to leave young wildlife alone."

Touching, picking up or even approaching young animals can leave behind human scent, which may attract predators and put the animal at risk. Contact with wildlife also increases the chance of spreading diseases and parasites such as rabies, ticks, Lyme disease and roundworms.

"We get a lot of calls this time of year about fawns, birds and baby rabbits that people think are abandoned or injured," said Vinnie Johnson. WVDNR wildlife biologist. "Most of the time, those animals are doing exactly what nature intended."

For example, does often leave fawns hidden for eight hours or longer while they search for food. These fawns rely on their camouflaged coats and lack of scent to stay safe. Approaching or handling a bedded fawn can put them in danger. Similarly, people often mistake fully-feathered fledgling birds for injured ones. If the bird is featherless and the nest is within reach, it can be carefully returned

The WVDNR is also reminding the public that it is illegal to possess wild animals without a per-

mit. Fines for unlawful possession of a fawn, bird, squirrel, bear cub or other wildlife range from \$20 to \$300, and may include jail time up to 100 days.

Summer Crappie Fishing

Summer

When it comes to summer crappie fishing, understanding their habitat is crucial for success. Crappies are highly adaptable fish, but they tend to congregate in areas that provide them with protection, food, and suitable water conditions. So, where do you start looking?

Structures with Submerged Vegetation

These structures provide shade, ambush points, and a place for crappies to suspend in the water column. Docks, in particular, can be very productive, as they often have a built-in food source in the form of baitfish and insects attracted to the structure. When fishing near-surface structures, focus on the 5-10 foot depth range, and be prepared to make precise casts.

it like a juicy worm wiggling on a hook – it's hard for crappie to resist! When using jigs with soft plastic trailers, make sure to choose trailers that match the natural forage in the water. For example, if you're fishing in an area with a lot of shad, use a trailer that mimics a shad. You can also experiment with different jig weights and retrieval speeds to see what works best for your specific fishing spot.

Crankbaits with Bright Colors

Crankbaits are another great option for summer crappie fishing. But here's the thing: you need to make them stand out. That's where bright colors come in. Crappie are attracted to bright, bold colors, especially in the summer when the water is warm and murky. Look for crankbaits with bright oranges, yellows, and greens – these colors are like a beacon calling out to crappie. And don't be afraid to experiment with different retrieval speeds and depths to see what works best for

your fishing spot.

Small Minnow-Imitating Lures
