

Whitetail Facts

It's finally October, and you whitetail deer. Use these insights know: season is now in full swing. For some of us, the season has been in full swing for months. For the rest of us, we have a short, jam-packed several weeks to land that monster buck on our trail cam.

Therefore, rather than twiddling our thumbs and waiting for that deer to make its way to our stand, let's make use of our time. Let's learn more about our game.

Knowing the game you hunt helps you plan and hunt more successfully. So, here are ten interesting facts that every hunter and huntress should understand about

to stalk your prey this season.

1. Whitetail Deer Are Very Agile When tracking a deer through the woods or waiting in your tree stand, it might seem like a buck is there one minute – then gone the next.

That's because whitetail deer are exceptionally agile. They can run 35-40 miles per hour and leap over obstacles 7-10 feet high.

A whitetail's powerful legs and acute balance enable swift, nimble movements through dense forests and rugged terrain, allowing them to evade predators and navigate complex environments with remarkable ease.

2. They Feed Often

On average, a whitetail deer will feed about four times in a 24-hour window. These deer need to eat around eight pounds of vegetation per one hundred pounds of body weight per day.

For example, a whitetail that weighs 150 pounds can be seen feasting on 12 pounds of vegetation throughout the day!

3. They Can Live a Long Time

Do you feel like you keep seeing the same buck year after year on your trail cams? It's possible!

Whitetails can live up to 20 years in the wild. Although only a few deer live to the age of ten, many live only two to three years.

A whitetail's large antlers result from three primary factors: nutritious food, increasing buck age, and good genes.

5. They Use Scent Glands for Identification

How does one deer recognize another deer? It's all about the smell.

Whitetail deer have scent glands between the two parts of the hoof on all four feet, outside of each hind leg, and on the inside of each hind leg. This makes communication and identification a piece of cake for these animals.

6. Antlers Grow Fast

grow around the last day of March and the first day of April. They usually grow at the rate of about a quarter-inch per day.

7. Does Can Have Multiple Fawns Female deer, or does, can give birth to one to three young at a time. This usually happens in May or June.

8. They Rest During the Day

More often than not, whitetails are at rest or inactive during daylight hours, making them crepuscular animals.

The ideal times to see whitetail deer feeding are from before dawn until several hours later and again from late afternoon until dusk.

9. They Swim

Whitetail deer can swim at a speed of up to 15 miles per hour. 10. A Whitetail's Vision is Very Distinct

They can only see shades of yellow and blue, and they can view landscapes, forests, fields, etc., at a 310-degree radius. In other words, wear orange and don't move.

Wounded Game Recovery: An unmanned aerial vehicle can be used to track and locate mortally wounded deer, bear and wild boar. Only one leashed dog can be used for this purpose.

Hemorrhagic Disease in Deer: Hunters should also be aware of ongoing reports of hemorrhagic disease (HD) in some deer populations across the state. HD is a naturally occurring virus that can affect white-tailed deer, and the WVDNR is monitoring the situation closely. DNR Mast Survey For 2025

ELKINS, W.Va. — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (WVDNR) announced today that hunters preparing for fall seasons may now consult the 2025 Hunting Outlook and Mast Survey, which details the abundance of wild fruits and nuts produced by 18 species of trees and shrubs and forecasts game harvests for the coming year.

According to the survey, the mast index is 2 percent above the statewide long-term average and 16 percent above 2024.

"Hard mast production, especially acorns from white oak and chestnut oak, is up this year and expected to be abundant and widespread across the state," said Avery Korns,

mast survey project leader for the WVDNR's Wildlife Resources Section. "However, soft mast production was variable and many species showed decreases across most or all of the surveyed ecoregions."

When mast is abundant, big game tend to move less and remain more dispersed, making them harder for hunters to locate. Reduced soft mast can cause wildlife to move more in search of food, creating localized opportunities in later months for hunters who do advance scouting.

Because mast production influences wildlife behavior, harvests for white-tailed deer and raccoon are predicted to be lower in 2025. According to the survey, the over-

Favorite Time Of The Year For Bass Fishing

We're not too far from one of in August. I didn't even look for my favorite times of the year, but we're not there yet. I'm talking about fall in Oklahoma, and my gut tells me it won't be much longer.

I fished a tournament on Lake Eufaula the second week of September, and the water temperature was in the 80s. At that temperature level, the fish are not concerned with chasing bait. They're still in that late summer pattern, and they still haven't made any transition to the backs of creeks.

During that tournament, I caught them early on topwater and then moved out to deep brush, timber and anywhere I had caught them

those shallow patterns.

At this point, we're probably two weeks away from the beginning of fall. We had a late summer, so it'll probably happen in early October. We just need a week of cool weather and it will get going.

In my experience, you know fall has arrived when you start seeing the deer moving around early in the morning and not just in the evenings. There's more life in nature.

On the water, you see shad flipping, and it's not just stagnant like it had been during late summer.



The other bait I'll have tied on is the War Eagle Screaming Eagle spinnerbait. It has smaller blades, and you can really burn it without it rolling over. It's a compact bait that matches the smaller fall baitfish.

Whatever you throw, don't get frustrated. One day can be tough and the next can be magical.

And stay positive. It's easy to get negative, but stay after it because you could run into them just about anywhere and when you do, they're going to be ready to bite.

DNR Antlerless Deer Seasons

Whether you're a seasoned hunt- LERLESS SEASON? er or planning your first trip into the woods, understanding West Virginia's antlerless deer season is crucial for a successful hunt. With specific regulations and season dates in place, this guide will help you stay informed and ready for the upcoming season. From identifying which deer you can legally harvest to knowing where and when to hunt, we've got you covered. Get ready to make the most of West Virginia's antlerless deer season and enjoy the many benefits it offers.

WHAT DEER CAN I LEGALLY HARVEST DURING THE ANT-

An antlerless deer is any deer without antlers. That part might be obvious, but additionally any deer with antlers that are not longer than three inches above the hairline are also considered antlerless deer. When in doubt, don't shoot anything with visible antlers.

When hunting antlerless deer, focus on areas with high deer activity, such as the edge of fields and trails as well as areas of high acorn abundance. Pay attention to wind direction to avoid being detected by a deer's keen sense

of smell, and set up in a location that gives you a clear, ethical shot. Early mornings and late afternoons are prime times to hunt, as deer are most active during these hours. Remember to stay patient and wait for the right opportunity to ensure a successful and responsible harvest.

WHEN ARE WEST VIRGINIA'S ANTLERLESS DEER SEASONS?

West Virginia's antlerless deer season is a split season, which means the hunting dates are divided into separate time periods throughout the fall and winter. This structure allows hunters multiple opportunities to hunt antlerless deer during different phases of the season, accommodating various schedules and hunting conditions. The split seasons also help manage deer populations by spreading out the harvest over several weeks, reducing pressure on the herd and allowing for more sustainable hunting practices.

Antlerless deer season dates to remember:

October 23-36 November 24 – December 7 December 11-14 December 28-31

WHERE CAN I HUNT DURING WEST VIRGINIA'S ANTLER-LESS DEER SEASON?

The antlerless deer firearms season will be open on public and private land in all or portions of the state's 51 counties that are open to deer firearms hunting. This gives hunters a wide range of environcontinue to the next page



ments to choose from, including state forests, wildlife management areas and private lands with written landowner permission. No matter what property type you plan to hunt, be sure to scout your area in advance to understand the terrain and locate deer activity.

The antlerless deer firearms season is closed in West Virginia's four bow-only counties (Logan, McDowell, Mingo and Wyoming). Portions of Fayette, Raleigh and Wayne counties are also closed to antlerless deer firearms hunting due to local management strategies. Hunters in these regions should be aware of these restrictions and plan their hunts in counties where the season is open. Always check for any special regulations or additional restrictions in the specific area where you plan to hunt, as they can vary by county and land type. License and Stamp Requirements

All antlerless deer must be taken on a Class N or NN stamp or LERLESS DEER IN WEST VIRwith a Class DT license. Resident landowners hunting on their own property (or their resident chil-

tenants) do not have to purchase a Class N or NN stamp. Only one antlerless deer may be taken on each stamp.



Calling In A Buck

Calling in a deer is one of the most exciting things you can do as a hunter; it means you are perfectly positioned and communicating directly with whitetail.

The weeks leading up to and shortly after early November are a hunter's favorite time of year, when does are coming into heat and bucks are up and moving, searching for their mate. With increased buck movement comes more opportunities for you to bag your next trophy.

So, how do you draw bucks into shooting range during the rut and this period of increased movement? Whether you are hunting the pre-rut, the middle of the rut, or the tail-end of the rut, here are the best tactics to call in shooter bucks.

1. Can Calls

When fawns are distressed or simply want comfort from their mother, they make a high-pitched bleating noise. This call causes a doe's maternal instincts to kick in and causes them to investigate **OUTDOOR** 304

Once the rut is in full swing, fawns are stable, and does disregard their maternal instincts. If you are hunting during the early season or the rut, letting out a few can calls even when you don't spot a deer isn't a bad idea.

Deer have exceptional hearing. You may have a big doe just beyond your visibility. However, make sure not to overcall either. as this behavior is not natural or believable.

2. Grunt Tubes

dominance over younger bucks and attract nearby does. That's why you need a grunt tube if you are hunting the rut.

This call imitates the grunt bucks make, causing mature bucks to head your way to investigate or challenge what they think is a smaller buck encroaching on their territory. Typically, the bigger the buck, the lower the grunt, so when using a grunt tube, your call's pitch should imitate a younger buck.

Grunting too deeply makes it sound like you're a massive male and will intimidate and push away Whitetail bucks actively grunt smaller bucks who feel they can't





3. Rattling Antlers

Rattling mimics the sound of two bucks fighting and is a useful tactic to use throughout the rut.

This attracts other bucks because they want to see what the fuss is all about and what other males are in their territory. If you've never heard two bucks fighting, check out YouTube to get an idea of how aggressive you should be with your rattling.

If you have some old antlers laying around, that is as real as it gets. Use antlers that are reflective of the deer in your area; you don't want to scare away a good buck



proper processing is key to preserving both the quality and nutrition of your wild game. Handling meat safely not only protects you from contamination but also ensures that every cut reaches your table in the best possible condition. Before you begin processing a harvest, make sure you've legally checked in your game at WVhunt.com. Need a refresher on how to do that? Check out this guide.

Start in the field by wearing disposable gloves and keeping your tools clean and your knife sharp. A dull knife can tear muscle fibers, waste meat and increase your risk of injury.

When processing a deer, remove the hide carefully, then trim away all hair and excess fat. Cut along the natural contours of the muscles to maximize your yield. Hindquarters and tenderloins are ideal for steaks and roasts, while neck and shoulder meat can be ground for burgers or sausage. Taking a little extra time during processing ensures you get the best cuts for freezing, cooking and sharing.

For beginners, taking your deer harvest to a local processor is a great option, but learning these basics yourself is an important part of the process and the first step toward delicious, lean meals that keep you coming back for more fall hunts.

FRESHNESS

Proper storage is essential to keeping your wild game flavorful, nutritious and safe to eat long

after it leaves the field. Because wild game is leaner than most commercial meats, it can dry out more quickly if not stored correct-

Vacuum sealing is the best option for long-term storage. It protects meat from freezer burn, locks in flavor and preserves tenderness. STORING WILD GAME FOR If vacuum sealing isn't available, tightly wrap cuts in plastic wrap and then add an airtight layer of freezer paper or heavy-duty aluminum foil. Label each package with the type of meat and the date it was harvested so you can rotate your freezer stock and enjoy it at its peak.

> Smaller cuts, like steaks or tenderloins, freeze more evenly and thaw faster than large roasts or whole cuts. Ground meat should be portioned into usable amounts to avoid repeatedly thawing and

THE 10 MOST COMMON HUNTING VIOLATIONS

While following the rules is simple once you know them, our Natural Resources Police Officers encounter the same violations season after season. Most of these issues can be avoided with a little preparation and attention to detail. Knowing what they are is the first step to keeping your hunt legal and enjoyable.

Hunting without landowner permission (trespassing)

HUNTING OR TAKING GAME OUT OF SEASON

Season dates are set to protect wildlife. Hunting outside these dates not only harms wildlife, it's illegal. Avoid making this mistake by reviewing the season dates for your target species and marking them on your calendar before heading out.

FAILING TO ELECTRONI-CALLY CHECK HARVESTED GAME

Checking big game is a requirement and helps biologists track harvest numbers and manage wildlife populations. Avoid making this mistake by checking your harvest within the required timeframe using the WVDNR's electronic game checking system. To learn more about this process, check out our Game Check Guide. POSSESSING WILDLIFE ILLEGALLY

egal possession. Avoid making this mistake by only taking possession of legal wildlife you have legally harvested and keep licenses and tags current.

TAKING MORE DEER THAN THE LEGAL BAG LIMIT

Bag limits prevent overharvesting and ensure deer populations and buck to doe ratios remain at healthy levels. Avoid making this mistake by knowing the bag limit for the county where you are hunting and keep track of your harvest throughout the season.

WITHOUT HUNTING THE **REQUIRED ADDITIONAL STAMPS**

Certain deer seasons require you to purchase an additional stamp(s) to take extra deer. For example, you need to buy an RB/RRB stamp to take extra deer during the archery season, an RG/RRG stamp for the buck firearm season and an RM/RRM stamp for the muzzleloader season. Avoid making this mistake by buying your hunting license and any required Ellie Groves got an early season stamps at the start of the year so bow buck in Nicholas County.

you're prepared for any season. NOT WEARING AT LEAST 400 SQUARE INCHES OF BLAZE ORANGE DURING FIREARMS **DEER SEASON**

Blaze orange makes you visible to other hunters and reduces the risk of accidents. Avoid making this mistake by wearing the required amount of blaze orange on your head, chest and back during firearms deer season, even if you're not hunting deer.

HUNTING FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE

Shooting from a moving or stationary vehicle is unsafe and unfair to wildlife. Avoid making this mistake by exiting your vehicle and making sure you are fully off the roadway before loading or firing your firearm.

HUNTING WITH A FIREARM IN A CLOSED COUNTY

Some counties restrict certain firearms for specific seasons to protect wildlife and public safety. Avoid making this mistake by checking the county-specific regulations in the current hunting digest before your trip.

HUNTING WITHOUT A VALID LICENSE

You'd be surprised how often our NRPOs encounter someone hunting without a valid license. Avoid making this mistake by purchasing your license before the season. Better yet, purchase a three-year license (Class X3 or XP3) and upgrade it to a license card so you can carry your license with you whenever you hunt.

"These Resources (WVDNR) today announced that the next segment of eral chances to experience bear the state's black bear firearms season will be open in select counties Sept. 20-26.

Additional black bear firearms season segments are scheduled for Oct. 4-10, Oct. 23-26, Nov. 24-Dec. 7, and Dec. 8-31. Archery and crossbow seasons for black bear starts Sept. 27. A special youth, Class XS and Class Q season will also be held Oct. 18-19.

"I want to encourage bear hunters to take advantage of the September seasons, which often coincide with the peak of acorn drop when bears are active and feeding heav-

seasons not only give hunters sevhunting in West Virginia but also play a vital role in managing a healthy population."

Resident hunters must purchase a bear damage stamp in addition to their hunting license. Nonresidents must purchase both a bear hunting license and a bear damage stamp. Licenses and stamps are available at WVhunt.com.

Hunters who harvest a bear are required to submit a premolar tooth from each bear. Those who harvest a female black bear are also encouraged to save the reproductive tract or all the entrails and submit them to the WVDNR for a Data collected from these submissions help biologists monitor the state's black bear population.


