




Buck Harvest Numbers Down

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – Preliminary data collected from game checking stations across the state indicate deer hunters in West Virginia harvested 43,226 bucks during the two-week buck firearms season, which ran from Nov. 22 through Dec. 4, according to Frank

Jezioro, Director of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources (DNR). The 2010 buck harvest was 31 percent less than the 2009 harvest of 62,986. The top ten counties for buck harvest were as follows: Preston (2,030), Randolph (1,817), Hardy (1,350), Greenbrier (1,348), Mason (1,264), Hampshire (1,261), Ritchie (1,236), Jackson (1,216), Lewis (1,141) and Wood (1,113).

This year's buck harvest is significantly lower than last year, with declines occurring across all DNR Districts. The largest percent decreases occurred in the western and central counties of the state. The harvest was 30th among all recorded antlered buck firearm seasons. Overall, 14 counties were above or within one buck harvested per square of the harvest objective and 37 counties were one or more bucks per square mile below the harvest objective.

White-tailed deer are a product of the environment. Too many deer

in antler development, decrease in reproduction and sometimes death due to starvation during winter months. The cumulative effects of too many deer over time causes a decline in herd condition, which actually reduces the deer herd's resiliency to years of poor mast conditions and harsh winter weather. year's unusually severe winter had a significant impact on the deer population and the overall 2010 buck firearms season harvest. Fortunately, 2010 has been a banner year for mast and overall, deer are in good physical condition entering the winter months.

Wildlife Biologists will analyze data from the combined 2010 deer seasons (i.e., buck, antlerless, archery and muzzleloader) before making appropriate recommendations for next year's deer seasons. These recommendations will be available for public review at 12 regulations meetings scheduled for March 14 and 15, 2011 (see current 2010 - 2011 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Summary page 5 or visit the DNR website at www. wvdnr.gov for scheduled times and places).

Director Jezioro reminds hunters that the traditional six-day antlerless deer season in selected counties on both public and private land ends Saturday, December 11. Muzzleloader deer season begins Dec. 13 and runs through Dec. 18. The Youth and Class Q/QQ antlerless deer season will be open on





Monday and Tuesday, Dec. 27 and 28 in any county with a firearms deer season, and will be followed by a three-day reopening of antlerless deer season (Dec. 29 - 31) in 46 counties or portions of counties (see 2010 - 2011 Hunting and Trapping Regulations Summary or visit the DNR website at www.wvdnr. gov for county and area listings).





Archery In Schools State Tournament

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. – As a result of the growing success of the Archery in the Schools Program (AIS), the Division of Natural Resources (DNR) will be hosting its Sixth Annual West Virginia State Tournament at the Veterans Memorial Field House located in Huntington. The DNR anticipates more than 600 students from across the state will be participating making this the largest indoor youth archery tournament ever held in the state of West Virginia.

The AIS Program is the DNR's largest and fastest growing educational program, reaching more than 50,000 students through the participation of nearly 250 schools. Since the DNR implemented the program in 2004, over 1,500 students have participated in five state tournaments with several hundred qualifying and competing at National continue to the next page

Tournaments located in Louisville, KY, according to Scott Warner, DNR Wildlife Resources Section, AIS Program Coordinator.

"With the interest in our state tournament, we're encouraging all participating schools to start working with their students now to get their registration material in before the February 25 deadline," said Warner. "We are encouraging all parents, Principals and teachers to actively support their AIS Program and consider coming to this year's tournament. Even if a school can not send a full team of 12 students, schools can still be represented by sending students to participate in the Individual Division."

Schools that have trained AIS instructors but have not yet purchased archery equipment still have the opportunity to participate in the tournament. "Certified instructors may volunteer to help with scoring and arrow-pulling at the tournament," said Warner. "In fact, it provides instructors first-hand knowledge of what goes on at a tournament, which would be of great benefit to their school. However, volunteers will need to contact us well in advance."


