Interesting Fishing Facts

1. Saugers See in the Dark

Walleyes are known for their marble-like eyes, which let them see well in dim light. Their retina has a layer of reflective pigment, called the tapetum lucidum, that intensifies any light the eye receives. (It's the same membrane that causes a cat's eyes to glow yellow.) But the walleye's close relative, the sauger, has even better night vision because the tapetum covers a much larger portion of its retinas.

2. Black, But Just Barely

Ever wonder where the term "black bass" came from? The fry of smallmouth bass turn coal black within a few days after they hatch. Even though the fry of largemouth and other bass species do not turn black, all members of the group (genus Micropterus) are referred to as black bass.

3. Orange Delight

Researchers studying walleye vision found that orange is the color most visible to walleyes, followed by yellow and yellow green. Surprisingly, red is the least visible color. No wonder you find so many orange and chartreuse lures in the tackle boxes of savvy walleye anglers.

4. On the Cool Side

White and striped bass are members of the temperate bass family, as opposed to black bass, which belong to the sunfish family. The term "temperate bass" refers to the moderate water temperature preference of members of this family. As a rule, they prefer temperatures a little lower than those preferred by largemouth or smallmouth bass.

5. Lights Out? Let's Eat

Research has shown that a sudden decrease in light level triggers walleyes to bite. That explains why the fish usually turn on just as the sun is disappearing below the horizon and the light intensity is rapidly decreasing. It also accounts for the hot bite that starts when the dark clouds preceding a thunderstorm roll in.

6. Not So Special

an adipose fin, right? Wrong. Several other fish species, including catfish, bullheads, madtoms, smelt, ciscoes and whitefish, also have an adipose fin (the small fin on the back just in front of the tail).

7. Tiny Teeth, But What a Bite Flathead catfish have a tooth pad consisting of hundreds of tiny, recurved teeth on the roof of their mouth. The pad helps them hold their prey securely, so it can't wiggle around and escape. So if you're inclined to stick your hand into a flathead's mouth to dislodge your hook, forget it. You might pull your hand out minus the skin.

8. Mud Cats in Name Only Flatheads are often called mud cats, giving anglers the impression that they scavenge dead food items off the bottom. But flatheads are more apt to eat live fish than any other catfish species. Channel cats are most likely to consume dead, stinky food (and bait) and blue cats are intermediate in their food preference.

9. Hungry Mothers
The very best time to catch a trophy

walleye is five to seven weeks after the fish have completed spawning. That's when the big females, famished after not having eaten for nearly two months, go on the prowl continue to the next page

for food. And with the natural supply of baitfish at its annual low, they're likely to hit almost anything you throw at them.


10. Sturgeons Big and Small Members of the sturgeon family are the largest fish inhabiting the fresh waters of North America-and some are also among the smallest. The white sturgeon, which is found in rivers along the Pacific Coast, has been known to reach a weight of almost a ton, and today's anglers of the Pacific Northwest commonly catch whites in the 200-to 300-pound range. Shovelnoses, on the other hand, seldom exceed a few pounds in weight in their Midwestern home waters.

11. On the Edge

Ever wonder why the teeth of a pike or muskie easily shear your line,





to tie on a wire leader when you're chasing those esocids.

12. No Wonder It's So Skinny What freshwater fish found in North America makes the longest spawning migration? The winner, hands down, is the American eel. The females spend most of their

lives in big rivers like the Mississippi. When spawning time approaches, they swim downstream to join the males at the river mouth, then they swim to the Sargasso Sea (a portion of the North Atlantic) to spawn.

13. Bladder Control

You might have noticed that some fish pulled from deep water can be released and will swim right back down, but others have trouble descending. That's because some fish (physostomous species like trout) can "burp" air as they're being pulled up, relieving the gas build-

up in their swim bladders, while others (physoclistous species like walleyes) do not have a connection between the swim bladder and the gut, so their swim bladders expand, greatly increasing their buoyancy.



DNR Seeks Trophy Deer & Fish

ROANOKE, W.Va. — The West Virginia Division of Natural Resources is asking hunters and anglers to enter showcase pieces for the big buck and trophy fish display at the National Hunting and Fishing Day celebration at Stonewall Resort State Park on Sept. 22-23.

Mounted trophy white-tailed bucks with a Pope and Young or Boone and Crockett score of 140 or greater that were legally harvested with a bow or gun may be entered in the display. The DNR also is seeking fish that meet the DNR's trophy citation guidelines.

"This display is a tremendous draw at West Virginia's Celebration of National Hunting and Fishing Day and attracts thousands of visitors each year," said display organizers James Walker and Tyler Evans, DNR wildlife biologists. "This is a great opportunity to show off your big buck or trophy fish."

The display is limited to the first 30 qualifying trophy bucks, and only 25 qualifying trophy fish, chosen by a selection committee, will be displayed. No more than five fish of any species will be accepted continue to the next page





crackers in some parts of their range because of their habit of eating aquatic snails, which they crush with special grinding teeth in their throat. Where snails are scarce, redears will forage on various small crustaceans, insects and fish fry.

15. The Original Chamois Fly One of the least known but most effective baits for trout is the water worm, which is the larval form of the crane fly (those big, slow-moving bugs that look like giant mosquitoes). You can often find water worms by digging through the mud and sticks of a beaver dam on your favorite trout stream.

16. Latch on to the Right Leech Leeches are one of the top baits for walleyes, but make sure you're using the right leech species. Ribbon leeches, which have firm bodies and minimal suction, make excellent bait, but a walleye will turn up

its nose at a horseleech or medicine leech, which have soft, squishy bodies and strong suction.

17. Waterdogs as Puppies Water dogs, which are the larval form of a tiger salamander, make good bait for bass, walleyes and pike. But once the young salamanders lose their gills and turn into adults, they don't work nearly as well. To prevent water dogs intended for bait from developing into adults, keep them refrigerated in water at a temperature of no more than 50 degrees.

18. Yummy! A Worm Inside Out Channel cats love catalpa worms, which can be found on the leaves of catalpa trees from late spring

through summer. To make a catalpa worm even more irresistible, cut off the head and then poke a matchstick through the body to turn the worm inside out. The extra scent helps cats find the bait more quickly.

19. Madtom Mealtime

One of the very best baits for walleye and smallmouth bass is the tadpole madtom, also known as the willow cat. These tiny catfish look a lot like bullheads, but the dorsal, caudal (tail) and anal fins are all connected. Be extremely careful when hooking a willow cat for bait. Their needle-sharp pectoral fins can prick you much worse than a bee sting.

20. Catfish in a Can

You might have trouble finding a bait shop that carries willow cats, but you can catch your own by stringing together some empty pop cans and then sinking them in a lake or river backwater inhabited by the tiny fish. Leave the cans overnight and pick them up the next morning; like other catfish, willow cats like to swim into holes, so the pop cans make an inexpensive trap.

21. Never Trust the Ice

You've probably heard that it's safe to walk on 3 inches of ice or drive a car on 10 inches. But is the ice

ever really safe? No! Schools of carp can gather under the ice and wear it away, occasionally even opening a hole. And groundwater might well up from the depths and melt the ice, as famously happened on several Minnesota lakes during the winter of 2002-2003.

22. Salmon With Handle

Not sure if that big salmon you caught is a coho or a chinook? Just grab it around the base of the tail and try to lift it. If it slips through your fingers, it's probably a coho; if it doesn't, it's a chinook. The continue to the next page

bony structure of a chinook's tail is much more rigid, making it easier to "tail" the fish.

23. Take the Temperature

Pike and muskies are both classified as cool-water fish, but there is a definite difference in the water temperature they prefer, especially among the larger members of each species. Pike more than 30 inches long favor water temperatures from 50 to 55 degrees, while muskies prefer temperatures of 67 to 72 degrees. Another big difference: Pike feed actively throughout the year and are a popular target of ice fishermen. Muskies feed much more sporadically in winter and are rarely caught by ice anglers.

24. Picky Eaters

Although most anglers believe muskies are voracious feeders, consuming just about everything in sight, they're actually much less aggressive than pike. Muskies are considerably more selective, and will examine your offering more closely. They'll often follow your bait for a distance and then turn away at the last second. A pike, on the other hand, will attack practically any kind of lure or bait that passes its way.

25. Muskies Gone Bad

Most of the stories of the muskie's voracious feeding habits are myth, but there are some notable exceptions, including documented cases of muskies taking small swimming dogs and even attacking humans splashing around in the shallows! In one Minnesota lake, a cordoned-off swimming area had to be closed after a rogue muskie found its way inside the netting and bit a small boy.

26. Teeth Spare Many anglers believe that pike lose

their teeth in the summer and don't bite. In fact, both pike and muskies continually shed old teeth and grow new ones. While it's true that pike fishing often gets tough during the summer months, the poor bite is probably related to a glut of baitfish or the fact that pike often move into deeper, cooler water as the summer

progresses.

Chronic Wasting Disease In WV

SOUTH CHARLESTON, W.Va. - Effective July 1, 2018, two eastern panhandle counties will be added to three that already have restrictions on the disposal and transport of deer carcasses. The restrictions are designed to combat the spread of chronic wasting disease (CWD). Berkeley and Mineral counties have been added to Hampshire, Hardy and Morgan counties as areas where restrictions apply.

Current research indicates that the abnormal protein which causes CWD, called a prion, is concentrated in the spinal cord and brain of infected deer. As a result, certain carcass parts have the potential to spread the disease.

"As part of our agency's ongoing efforts to detect the presence of CWD and focus on disease management actions, a larger portion of West Virginia's eastern panhandle has been added to the current area where restrictions apply," said Stephen McDaniel, director of the West Virginia Division of Natural Resources.

Hunters may transport deer carcasses that were not killed inside the containment area through the containment area.

Research also indicates supplemental feeding and baiting of deer increases the chance of disease transmission far above the normal clustering of deer on natural and ag-

ricultural feeding areas. Berkeley, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Jefferson, Mineral and Morgan counties have been under a ban on baiting or feeding deer since 2015. Reducing the number of times infected and non-infected animals congregate by prohibiting supplemental feeding and baiting are generally accepted management practices for slowing the spread of an infectious disease among wildlife.

The West Virginia DNR will continue to update management actions designed to control the spread of this disease and prevent further introduction to new areas as information from deer testing within West Virginia is gathered and scientists across the country provide more information on how to combat CWD in white-tailed deer.

Summer Catfishing

Leverage The Heat For Channel Catfish

Catching channels in the late summer usually offers some excellent action. You can catch a lot of fish in a short time period and catching larger channel catfish is an option as well. The trick to consistency in the heat of the summer is to leverage the heat, the behavior of channel catfish in the heat of the summer

These fish will flock to areas with high oxygen levels and also "safe harbor" from the heat. Pay close attention to when and where you catch fish and put the patterns together when you are fishing in the heat.

Finding cooler water, cover or even areas with higher oxygen concentration can make all of the difference when targeting summer channel catfish.

Punch The Channel Catfish

Fishing the summer heat provides many opportunities and learning to leverage opportunities in any weather pattern or season is one of the main keys to being a great anglers.

Scent travels farther in warm than it does colder water. The scent of any bait is "amplified" and has a further reach. When using something for catfish bait with a very strong scent you simply have that



Chum Them Up

With the scent carrying further in warmer water this makes chumming or baiting a hole for catfish very effective. It's not a technique that usually brings in monster catfish, but for fast action in the hot summer it's a great option.

Use some soured wheat, milo or range cubes and chum a few areas to fish and one of them will usually produce. Experiment with cover, structure and locations to learn what works best and then rinse and repeat.

Baiting a hole or repeatedly throwing chum in an area for an

extended period of time is a good option during this time as well. Baiting a hole for channel catfish will produce excellent fishing as long as you keep baiting.

Fishing baited catfish holes during the end of the summer is a trick used by catfish guides throughout the south to help deal with the challenges of the summer.

Time The Flathead Catfish

The late summer bite for flathead catfish can be very good. Like all fishing for flathead catfish it can be slow at times as well with a lot of sitting and waiting. The rewards are great when you do hook one though and the fight more than pays off for the waiting.



Once they key in on that peak time they narrow their fishing down to that timeframe. Just keep in mind that the fish will change and can even change from one area of a lake or river to another.

.Drift Fish For Scattered Fish

When targeting blue and channel catfish drift fishing can be an effective way of catching fish in the summer months (or any time). Whether you're targeting blues or channels, finding scattered fish or concentrations of fish drift fishing can be a great approach. Drift fishing is also a great way for you to locate and catch blues and channels if you are just getting started or are having trouble finding and catching fish.

Drifting allows you to cover a lot of water and can increase your

potential of locating and catching fish. When you key in on a specific area or depth that is producing then you can continue to focus on that depth and area while drifting or use your sonar to narrow down the target area and anchor up.

the more time you spend on the water and the more you learn the more fish you will catch.

Drift fishing for channel catfish also has tendency to produce larger channel catfish than fishing prepared bait or fishing over baited holes. Set up with your preferred catfish rig like a slip sinker rig or santee rig with a 5/0 circle hook and some cut bait or preferred channel catfish bait and start fishing.

When drifting for blues use a 5/0 or 7/0 circle hook and a slip sinker rig or santee rig. Bait up with fresh caught shad or your preferred cut bait and it's pretty hard to not catch fish.

Remember when targeting blue catfish that fresh caught bait is going to catch more fish than frozen. Night Patterns and Success

Night fishing for catfish in the late summer is a great option. Targeting catfish at night not only allows you to target fish on the move and feeding in different areas but allows you to beat the heat and stay comfortable.

Flathead fishing is usually great at night in the summer. The fish will be larger but you'll generally catch fewer fish.

Channel catfish fishing at night can produce larger channel catfish and numbers of fish as well.

The same general principles apply when night fishing and fishing in the day as far as techniques, catfish rigs, baits and catching fish. The big difference is that when the sun sets bait fish will often move into areas where you won't find them during the day and there are good numbers of fish in these areas.

Pay close attention as the sun begins to set and watch for activity in the water. Look for active bait fish and fish feeding on them.

Longstanding Record

One of the most longstanding state record fish in West Virginia happens to be the flathead catfish. In 1956, L.L. McClung pulled a 52 inch, 70 pound giant out of the Little Kanawha River in the Wirt/ Wood County area. For reference, the United States was recently out of the Korean War and transistor radios were first invented in that era of time. Fast forward sixty-two years and a larger flathead has yet to be caught and verified as the state record.

Is a state record flathead lurking the muddy bottom of our state's waters? In my opinion, their are probably multiple state record cats alive today in West Virginia. The Ohio, Kanawha, and Little

Kanawha can all have one sipping down hand size bluegills on their mud bottoms near a brush pile. Burnsville Lake has had flatheads caught and released that pushed the scales way past sixty pounds. It is even rumored that a state record was caught and released at Burnsville because the fisherman thought the record weight was more than 70 pounds.

Anyone targeting the state record flathead would need to use exceptionally large gear and bait. I know of forty pound catfish that have fallen victims to baits almost twenty inches long. If I was going after a state record flathead, I would be using a live channel cat or smallmouth bass in the right location.



It is legal to use gamefish for flatheads if the gamefish was caught on rod and reel.

In conclusion, while the L.L. Mc-Clung fish is a very stately record, it is quite breakable. Grab yourself some heavy duty gear and head to your nearest deep hole or brush pile. Odds are that some whiskered beast is lurking below.





Finding Summer Smallmouth Bass

It's often said with much frustration that smallies disappear after they spawn and move off the beds. That's a little bit true, I suppose, but a more accurate description of what they do is roam out in deep water. It's more like they're everywhere than it is that they're nowhere. And, what they do is site specific.

In the deeper Great Lakes and some of the bigger, deep lakes in the North they tend to act almost like lake trout. By that I mean that they feed on smelt and are often found at extremely deep depths. Finding them between 40 and 60 feet is common, often over water that's between 80 and 100 feet deep.

It's tough to find them at those depths. That's why so many anglers

think they've disappeared or traveled to parts unknown. However, if you adjust your SONAR properly and spend the time it takes to find them you can catch them. They are feeding.

In shallower places, like the western end of Lake Erie they seem to relate more to structure. The offshore rock piles in Erie are legendary for producing large numbers of big smallmouth when the weather is miserably hot. My guess is that those fish are generally resident bass. They move into those places and stay until they've eaten everything in sight.

If you are lucky, and a mega school moves in, you'll know it immediately. You'll catch a bass on almost every single high spot, and they'll all look perfect — not a

mark on them.

At times, though, it looks like they continue to the next page

move from one rock pile or structure break to another. In my mind they're moving back and forth to take advantage of whatever's there to eat. In most cases that'll be gobies.

In the shallower, natural lakes — again, in the northern part of our country — it seems like they do the same thing except that they don't have the deep water available. They're likely to move with the forage but in water that's a lot shallower. The western part of Lake Erie may not be as deep as the eastern part but it's still deeper than many natural lakes. What all the movements I've described have in common is that summer smallmouth are forage related. I think that's just as true of the shallow, "rock pile" bass as it is of the deep, "smelt" bass or the shallow natural lake bass. And because they're relating to forage they are going to be moving. Don't expect to catch them two or three days in a row in

the same spot.

If you're looking for hot weather smallmouth, I suggest you start by analyzing the water you're fishing. You need to know its general depth, basic structure and what forage is available. Once you've done that you can start your open water search, and it's likely you'll spend more time staring at your SONAR screen than you will fishing. When you do find them, though, it'll be a time to remember.

3. Use Live Fishing Bait TipsSummerBluegill blog Kids love fishing for bluegill.

Bluegill are voracious eaters of small insects, crustaceans and worms. A wriggly worm or kicking cricket will attract bluegills quickly. Live baits are especially interesting to children. Kids will often spend more time playing with the bait than fishing. My 4-year-old granddaughter, Ally, once gave all 12 of my minnows names before we used them for bait. She asked dozens of questions about the minnows and the fish that would eat them. The enjoyable conversation gave grandpa the open door to teach simple conservation concepts.

4. For Bigger Fish, Go Deeper

Bluegill can be found in every sector of a pond or small lake. Kids like fast action and catching plenty of bluegill will not be a problem. On the other hand, to catch bigger bluegill, you will often have to fish a little deeper to get away from the hordes of smaller fish. Dropping your bait a few feet down near a boat dock piling, or other structure, will do the trick.

5. Have Fun Fishing

Most serious bluegill fishermen will tell you that they fish for bluegills because it is so much fun. Bluegill are aggressive and

Bass Fishing Tips

1. Save Shredded Worms

When your plastic worms get torn up, save 'em. Bass like to ambush wounded prey, so a beat-up worm is perfect to use, especially in shallow water.

2. Red Fools the Fish

In shallow cover — wood, stumps, clumps of grass — I like to use a spinner bait with a red or pink head, and a crank bait with red hooks. The red makes the fish think the bait's injured, and they'll bite at it.

When you cast, stop halfway instead of following through, similar to a check swing in baseball. This makes the lure hit the surface of the water a few feet before your target, so the lure skitters over the water. It's a good way to get under docks and other structures.

4. Keep Your Hooks Sharp

I use a file to sharpen my hooks every time I catch a fish and before every trip. It takes 30 seconds. Bass have boney jaws, so a sharp hook is more apt to penetrate the fish.




